Ice Hockey, by birth and upbringing a Canadian sport, is an offshoot of □eld hockey. Some historians suggest that the □rst game was played in Montreal in December 1879. Others believe that earlier games took place in Kingston, Ontario or Halifax, Nova Scotia. The □rst governing body of the sport was the Amateur Hockey Association of Canada, formed in 1887. Operating in northern Michigan from 1904 to 1906, the International Hockey League was the □rst professional league.

Founded in 1908, the International Ice Hockey Federation (IIHF), is a federation of member national hockey associations governing the sport of ice hockey and in-line hockey for both men and women


Ice hockey (frequently simply called hockey in countries where it is the most popular form of hockey) is a team sport played on ice, in which skaters use sticks to direct a puck into the opposing team's goal. It is a fast-paced and physical sport. Ice hockey is most popular in areas that are sufciently cold for natural reliable seasonal ice cover, such as Canada, the northern United States, the Nordic countries (especially Sweden and Finland), and Russia.


With the advent of indoor arti □cial ice rinks it has become a year-round pastime in these areas. Ice hockey is one of the four major North American professional sports. Worldwide the National Hockey League (NHL) is the highest level for men and the Canadian Women's Hockey League (CWHL) and the Western Women's Hockey League (WWHL) are the highest level for women. It is the of □cial national winter sport of Canada, where the game enjoys immense popularity. While only six of the thirty NHL franchises are based in Canada, Canadians make up a slight majority of the league's players.


#### Rules and Equipment

Ice hockey is played on a rectangular rink with curved corners whose length may vary from 184 to 200 ft (56-61 m), its width from 85 to 98 ft (26-30 m). Six players—a goalie, a center, two defensemen, and two forwards—all of whom are on ice skates, make up a team. The rink is surrounded on all sides by walls 3 1/2 to 4 ft (1.06-1.22 m) high. The goal mouths are 4 ft (1.22 m) high and 6 ft (1.83 m) wide and are set 10 ft (3.05 m) out from each end of the rink, which is divided by colored lines in the ice into three zones (attacking, neutral, and defending) that are each 60 ft (18.29 m) long. A puck, once made of rubber but now of composite material, 1 in. (2.54 cm) thick and 3 in. (7.62 cm) in diameter, and frozen to reduce resiliency, is the object used in play. The weight, size, and shape of the sticks used to hit the puck are standardized. After a face-off (the dropping of the puck between two opposing players by an of cial), the team in possession of the puck seeks to maneuver it past the other team and into its net. Each goal counts one point. The game is divided into three 20-min periods; overtime periods in case of ties are used in certain professional games. In this fast and body-bruising sport, players use heavy protective equipment, and there is unlimited substitution. A player detected by the referee in roughing, tripping, high-sticking, or other violations must spend two minutes (a minor penalty) or more (major penalties) off the ice in the penalty box, and his team must continue play shorthanded. #### THE STANLEY CUP

THE STANLEY CUP WAS DONATED TO THE CANADIAN AMATEUR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION BY SIR FREDERICK A. STANLEY (LORD STANLEY OF PRESTON), THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF CANADA FROM 1888-1893. IT WAS PRESENTED TO THE 1893 AHA CHAMPION, MONTREAL AMATEUR ATHLETIC ASSN., WITHOUT A CHALLENGE. THERE HAS BEEN A PLAYOFF EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER. IN 1914, THE CHALLENGERS WERE LIMITED TO THE CHAMPION OF THE NATIONAL HOCKEY ASSOCIATION (EASTERN PROFESSIONAL, FORMED 1910), AND THE CHAMPION OF THE PACIFIC COAST HOCKEY ASSOCIATION (WESTERN PROFESSIONAL, FORMED 1912). THE NHA BECAME THE NHL IN NOVEMBER 1917. FROM 1918-1926, THE RESPECTIVE NHL AND PCHL CHAMPIONS PLAYED OFF FOR THE CUP (IN 1923 AND 1924 THE WESTERN CANADA HOCKEY LEAGUE CHAMPION JOINED TO MAKE IT A THREE-WAY CHALLENGE). THE PCHA DISSOLVED AFTER THE 1925-26 SEASON, AND THE NHL PLAYOFFS DECIDED THE WINNER OF THE STANLEY CUP THEREAFTER.
