Sister Mildred Adams Coleman helped so much with the church history where she obeyed at an early age.

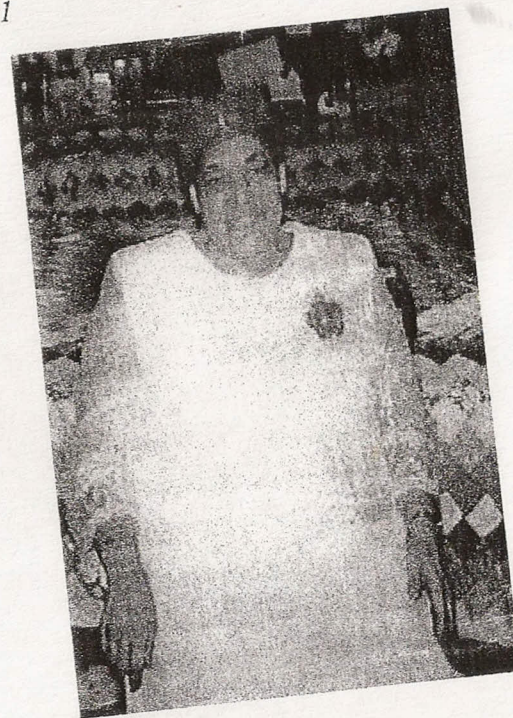
