

Ulysses Guiser

Services for Ulysses Guiser of Brookhaven are Jan. 21 at 2 p.m. at St. Paul M.B. Church in Brookhaven with burial in Carver Heights Cemetery.

Mr. Guiser, 81, died Jan. 16, 1993, at King's Daughters Hospital. He was born on May 14, 1911, to Leslie Guiser and Elizabeth Guiser, who preceded him in death.
