*Mr. Curtis Lee Williams was born December 27, 1933 to Ulysses Williams and Sallie Pierce in Lincoln County, Mississippi.*

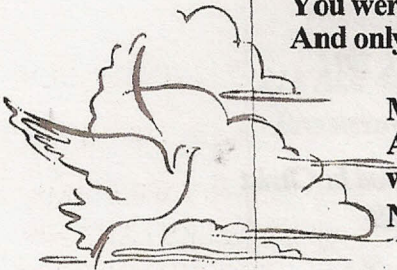
