

Wild fire ...

A wildfire pushed by high winds ripped through tall grass Friday afternoon east of Highway 33 near 4000N. The blaze threatened three homes for a time but were protected by Teton County Fire Department crews. "Two of the houses were very, very close calls which would have been complete losses," said Bret Campbell, fire chief. The blaze took off after a homeowner was burning weeds and 30 MPH winds came up, said Scott Wood, division chief. About 30 acres burned, and there were no injuries.
