1. Outstanding Leader Award	For outstanding troop leadership in the delivery of the Girl Scout program to girls that merits recognition.	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 2 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout troop leader or assistant leader *Must have completed appropriate training for position Min. Basic & Program age level training *Must serve as a role model to girls by living the Girl Scout Promise and Law
2. Outstanding Volunteer Award	For outstanding service <u>beyond</u> the expectations of the position that benefits the service team. Given to an adult working in a capacity other than leader.	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 2 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout, serving in a capacity other than troop leader *Must have completed appropriate training for position Min. Basic training *The quality of service must warrant and area-wide recognition
3. Newcomer of the Year	For outstanding service <u>beyond</u> the expectations of a person new to Green Hills Council	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 2 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout *Must have been registered in Green Hills for 2 years or less *Must have completed appropriate training *Service given must be <u>above & beyond</u> expectation
4. Appreciation Pin	To recognize outstanding service to at least one geographic/service area. <i>(This is a higher honor than the Outstanding Volunteer Award.)</i>	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 2 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout *Service performed must be outstanding <u>above & beyond</u> what is expected for the position * Must benefit at least one service area or operational activity of the Council and contribute to the attainment of the Council goals & objectives
5. Honor Pin	To recognize outstanding service to two or more geographic areas <i>(This award is a higher honor than the Appreciation Pin.)</i>	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 3 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout *Must benefit at least TWO service areas or a broader area of work within the Council and contribute to the attainment of the Council goals & objectives
6. Thanks Badge	To recognize outstanding service that benefits the entire Council or the entire Girl Scout organization. <i>(This is a higher honor than the Honor Pin.)</i>	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 4 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout *Service must have benefited the total Council or Girl Scout organization *Must include evidence of administrative and organizational skills and accomplishments so significantly <u>above & beyond</u> the call of duty that no other award would be appropriate
7. Thanks BadgeII	To recognize continued outstanding service given by a Thanks Badge recipient.	*Complete Nomination Application *AND must be accompanied by 4 other letters of endorsement	*Must currently be registered as an adult Girl Scout *Must be a previous recipient of the Thanks Badge *Must include evidence of an individual who continues to provide outstanding service that surpasses the earlier achievement

Other Commonly Asked Questions

Q: Who may write a Nomination or Letters of Endorsement?

A: Parents, girls in the troop, other Girl Scout volunteers, community leaders, staff at the Girl Scout Service Center, etc. all may write Nominations or Letters of Endorsements.

Q: When are the Nomination Applications and Letters of Endorsement due?

A: Nomination #1-3 are due at the Service Center by January 15. Nominations #4-7 are due at the Service Center by February 15.

Q: Who decides if a person will receive recognition?

A: The Recognition Task Group (volunteers) will review all material and approve recognitions.

Q: When are awards presented?

A: Awards #1-3 are awarded at the Spring District Meetings in February. Awards #4-7 are presented at the Council Annual Meeting & Recognition Banquet in April.

Q: If I have questions about a person's qualifications or past recognitions, whom should I contact?
