JUJITSU

772-481 BC: Reference made to Jujitsu during the Choon Chu era in China


230 BC: Wrestling sport of *Chikura Kurabe* appears in Japan. From then onward, many different schools of Jujitşu formed

1532: Takenouchi Hisamori founds *Takenouchi-Ryu*, the primal system for the teaching of arts similar to Jujitsu

Most modern Jujitsu ryu can trace their lineage directly back to Takenouchi

c. 1559: Chin Genpin, Chinese priest, and Hideyoshi Toyotomi bring Kempo, "kicking and striking", to Japan

1603-1868, Edo period: Weapon skills yield to weaponless styles known as Jujitsu. Estimated over 750 Jujitsu systems formed.
