We are making preparation to resume our church services on Sunday, May 31, 2020 at 9:30 am. Please adhere to the following protocol we have adopted based on the State of Massachusetts COVID-19 guidelines:

- If you are sick, please stay home
- A temperature check will be taken as you enter the building
- Masks are required, at all times, while in the building
- Please maintain social distancing of 6 feet – please, no hugging, no shaking hands, no fist bumping or high-fiving
- When you enter the Sanctuary, an Usher will help you find your assigned seat. Please look for your picture taped to the pew. They have been arranged 6 feet apart.
- No food or drink in the Sanctuary
- There will be no bulletins distributed, no blankets, no tissue boxes, no bibles and no hymnals in the pews
- When exiting the church, please use the door assigned to your side of the church
- Do not congregate in the church. If you wish to socialize, please leave the church building and meet outside, maintaining 6-foot distance
- There will be hand sanitizer at five different locations within the church building; when entering and leaving and in the fellowship room.
- Your tithing offering can be placed in the baskets at the Sanctuary entrance and exit or you can mail them, use direct billing or PayPal.
- On Communion Sunday, disposable communion cups will be available and you can take one as you enter the Church Sanctuary
- Any children services shall remain closed until such time that there is additional guidance
- Please do not leave tissues or other items in the pews. Be sure to remove anything you brought into church and take it with you or throw it in the trash. Thanks so much
