

The CommUnity Torah

- 1. Why should I have my own Torah letter? Imagine writing your own Torah Scroll by endowing a letter, or a sentence for yourself or a loved one. The very last Mitzvah in the Torah is to write a Torah Scroll.
- 2. Why is the Torah important in these times? In the book of Daniel: "... There shall be a time of trouble such as there never was since there was a nation until that time. And that time your people shall be delivered, every one who shall be found written in the book." (Daniel, 12:1). The greatest blessing for protection is thru unity. Interestingly the merit of uniting can be accomplished by buying a letter in a Sefer Torah.

3. Why is the Torah so important to us?

The Torah belongs to each one of us by right. We all have a right to claim our share. A Torah from which even one letter is missing cannot be used. So every single one of us is needed. The Torah joins all the separate letters, and they become one unit. Whether a child or an adult, having a letter in the Torah expresses our being part of the unity of the entire Jewish people.
