#### **Series Rules**

It is our policy to actively and equally enforce all the rules and regulations.

Rules are per WKA 2004 Technical Inspection Manual. The following exceptions will also apply:

- A. It is the responsibility of each driver to have a copy of this book and 2004 WKA Tech Manual, and be familiar with all of its contents.
- B. In the interest of safety, we reserve the right to refuse entry or remove a participant from the race and/or facility for unsafe actions.
- C. Schedules are subject to change due to situations beyond our control.
- D. A kart with no bodywork or CIK bodywork is allowed to weigh 20lbs. less than the assigned minimum weight except in those classes where CIK bodywork is only allowed.
- E. 2 Cycle Tech for exhaust and transfer ports will be done with L.A.D. type tech tools.
- F. Any gas and oil fuel test will be per Digatron meter set to -75 with Cyclohexane (C6H12). Fuel must not exceed "0". Must have sufficient quantity of fuel after the race for testing (suggest one quart). Also a fuel sample may be taken for chemical analysis to determine the presence of illegal additives. Any open fuel gas and/or alcohol may be subject to fuel test to determine presence of illegal additives.
- G. Snell 95 helmets per 2004 WKA are required. Inside label is required. Hair cannot extend outside the helmet while on the track (head sock to retain hair is recommended).
- H. Water with wetting agents only is permitted for all water-cooled engines. No glycol or permanent antifreeze. No permanently sealed cooling systems.
- I. No push restarting of any stalled (engine) kart at any point around the racetrack at any time.
- J. Sprint 125 shifter kart race starting procedure will be determined by race director at each track due to track restrictions and/or club rules.
- K. Stop & Go penalty signs will be given on the front straight at all tracks for on-track rules violations such as creeping at the start of the race, intentionally bumping other karts, pushing other karts, or any other listed safety infractions. Competitors who ignore the stop & go signals will be subject to a one-lap penalty or disqualifications at the end of the race.
- L. Those running for WKA regional points must have a WKA decal on the front of their kart.

#### **Red Flag Situation**

When a red flag is shown, drivers are to proceed safely to the starting grid and line up by original starting grid position. Neither driver nor crew will be allowed to work on the kart until the race is continued (green flag is raised) or instructed by race officials. The clock will either keep running or be a complete restart at the discretion of the race director. When the track is clear, the race will either A) continue if there is more time remaining to race than has been raced, or B) be complete if there is less time remaining to race than has been raced at the discretion of the race director. In the event of a race ending on a red flag, the driver or drivers involved in causing the red flag will get the end positions on the last completed lap. Drivers must report to scales and post tech unless otherwise instructed by race officials.

#### **End of Race**

The checkered flag denotes the end of the race. Drivers race to the flag, and are scored for the last time as each one passes the checkered flag. The winner is determined to be the kart that travels furthest in the allowed time. This kart does not need to take the checkered flag.

**Series Rules** 

#### Rain Racing

A race deemed a rainout would award 200 points plus the number of karts to drivers in the class. The race officials will determine a race to be a rainout before or during an event. If the event is past the halfway point, it will be ruled a complete race. Scaling and post-tech will be required at the discretion of the race officials. Finishing positions will be awarded based on the last completed full lap. Every attempt will be made to get races off the grid under dry conditions. This may mean altering the daily schedule. You may be allowed to race for a trophy only during rain, not points (subject to race director and minimum number of karts requirement). A driver must be entered to earn rain points.

#### **Daily Practice Schedule**

We will actively pursue a common daily practice schedule at all events. Daily practice session groups:

- All sprint karts except gearbox
- All enduro karts except gearbox
- All Gearbox: sprint and enduro, Unlimited, 250 Twin and over 100cc enduro karts
- Novice Karts (will practice between the end of round one and the beginning of round two)

Group practice order will be adjusted each day to avoid the last practice group being the first race groups. These groups may be split up into more groups if number of karts is too large for a track.

#### **Electronic Scoring**

The AMB TranX160 Electronic Scoring System will be used for the entire 2004 season. You must register your transponder at the time of entry and have that transponder on your kart when you arrive at the grid. Transponders will be for sale at some tracks. Some rental transponders may be available at some tracks. We encourage each racer to own a transponder.

The legal entrant is the only one allowed to operate a kart on the track during a race. The legal entrant is the qualified driver who has registered for the specific class currently on the track. Any driver who illegally enters the track during an ongoing race will have all Mid-States points revoked in all his/her classes and may be asked to leave the track facilities. Substitute drivers must report to registration before the race is underway.

#### Race Discrepancy Report

If you encounter problems with Scoring, Tech, Scales or other race processes that need correction, you must fill out a Race Discrepancy Report in order to receive correct resolution. The Race Discrepancy Report is available at registration. This report is to be filled out, signed, dated, including time of submission, and delivered back to registration or to the race director for review. No action will be taken to resolve a race discrepancy (protest) unless this procedure is followed. The report must be submitted within one hour of the race results posting.

#### **Scoring Procedure**

- 1. When the results are compiled, they will be posted on the bulletin board.
- 2. At this time, if a driver finds a discrepancy in the finishing results and/or post tech of his/her race, a written and signed Race Discrepancy Report has to be submitted as reviewed in Race Discrepancy Report section in the previous page.
- 3. If the driver is waiting settlement of a scoring discrepancy for a trophy finishing position, that driver's kart must pass post tech to verify the legality of the kart while the scoring discrepancy is being reviewed.
- 4. Once the tech inspector has released a driver from post tech inspection, the driver cannot return to tech for further inspection.

To receive a finishing position, a driver must: 1) Be entered in that class, 2) Grid or appear on a lap chart, 3) Weigh-in, 4) Pass post tech, 5) Sign out at scales and post tech. A driver who signs in and does not grid or appear on a lap chart will be noted as a Did Not Show, DNS, and will be counted as an entry and receive 0 points. A driver who is transported or detain by medical personal due to an on-track accident, he/she will receive points for their finishing position. If the driver is entered in other races and can not medically compete, the driver will be given last place points.

Series overall points will count 4 of 5. A disqualification, DQ, for on-track rule violations or a technical violation in post tech cannot count as the drop race. To be eligible for year-end series awards, each driver must be entered in at least three events. A tiebreaker will be the best finish the last time the two competitors raced head to head. A driver will receive 75 bonus points if they attend each event for that class.

\*\*Classes 12 & 47 will count as one championship, similar to WKA, counting 8 of 10 and a driver must enter at least six races to qualify for year-end trophies.\*\*

#### **Awards**

Trophies will be given at each event, determined by the club running the event. Series trophies will not be awarded immediately after the last race of the season. Championship points results for the season will be compiled and mailed to the top ten qualifying finishers in each class by October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2004. Drivers will have two weeks to review their individual point standings and contact us if any corrections are necessary. Awards will be distributed at a series banquet at a central location to be determined.

All 2003 Series Champions will have a reserved pole starting position in the class that they won. *New for 2004 at Road America, those winners from 2003 will start second unless the class is a Road America class only where they will start on the pole.* The rest of the grid line up will be assigned on a first come, first served basis. No preferred starting positions at Gateway event. No qualifying will be done. All WKA regional drivers must have WKA identification for registration and include membership number on entry form in order to receive WKA regional points.

**Dual Brake System Requirements** 

#### The following is each club's rule on the dual brake system requirement

KART (Gateway event) - Dual brake system will NOT be required, but it is suggested, for any kart powered by 110cc engines or less except Spec 125 Sprint.

Michigan Kart Club (Grattan event) - Dual brake system will be required for all karts per WKA rules (all karts except for Briggs karts) for all WKA regional classes and non-WKA classes unless specified in class description.

Badger Kart Club (Road America event) - Dual brake system will be required for those karts running for WKA regional points in WKA regional classes. Those karts running in a WKA regional class NOT running for WKA regional points will NOT be required to run dual brake system, but it is suggested.

Indianapolis Kart Club (Putnam Park event) - Dual brake system will be required for those karts running for WKA regional points in WKA regional classes. Those karts running in a WKA regional class NOT running for WKA regional points will NOT be required to run dual brake system, but it is suggested.

River Valley Kart Club (Blackhawk Farms) - Dual brake system will be required for those karts running for WKA regional points in WKA regional classes. Those karts running in a WKA regional class NOT running for WKA regional points will NOT be required to run dual brake system, but it is suggested.

#### Please see non-WKA class descriptions for dual brake system requirements for those classes.

NRRS committee member, Van Gilder has submitted the following list of ways to achieve a legal dual brake system.

- 1. A four-wheel braking system that includes a rear axle brake, and separate front wheel brakes. (This system is required on all karts powered by 110 cc engines or larger except Spec 125 Sprint.)
- 2. A rear brake system with two master cylinders and two calipers. This system may use one or two rear discs. The system may be designed or adjusted such that both systems apply braking force at the same time, or it may use one as a primary braking system and the second as a delayed system.
- 3. A rear brake system with a standard master cylinder and caliper and a second with a smaller (WKA acceptable) master cylinder and caliper that would take over if the primary system failed.
- 4. If a kart is equipped with a 4 piston rear caliper, two master cylinders may be used, one to actuate the right side of the caliper and the other to actuate the left side of the caliper. In this case, if one system fails, the other will continue to operate. Please note that using this design will reduce the hydraulic advantage by 50%. That means that under normal operation conditions, the pedal will move half as far to actuate the brakes and require twice the pressure.

Please understand that the objective of this rule is redundancy. Whatever design you use, your brake system must continue to function if one of the two systems fails.

Those running for WKA regional points must have a WKA decal on the front of their kart.

## BKC Rules and Procedures at Road America

ALL KARTS MUST BE PRE-TECHED BEFORE PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT.

THE ARMBANDS ISSUED AT THE GATE AND REGISTRATION MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE GROUNDS FOR THIS EVENT.

## FRIDAY – PRE-TECH AND PRACTICE PROCEDURE

- 1. Bring your Helmet, Kart and show Proof of Race Entry, namely your driver Armband to the Pre-Tech person.
- 2. Those who have paid for Practice on Friday will be issued a SPECIAL STICKER validating their access to the track. ALL participants MUST affix the Special Practice sticker to the CENTER of their helmet DIRECTLY ABOVE THE FACE SHIELD.
- 3. The Driver armband must be worn by all drivers at all times. Any driver accessing the track proper must show his driver armband to the flagman at the pit entrance to the track.

NOTE: Any kart or driver on the track without the proper armbands, or Sticker on their helmet will be subject to disqualification.

- 4. Upon completion of Pre-Tech, a sticker will be attached to your kart. In order to receive an award, Mid-States, CES, MARRS or WKA regional points, this sticker must be present on your kart at post-tech weigh in.
- 5. For Friday's practice sessions ALL driver's MUST apply at least one race number to his or her kart before practicing.

## RACE DAYS - SATURDAY AND SUNDAY

No one without a pre-tech sticker, proper armband, and race numbers properly affixed to their kart and a transponder firmly in place will be allowed to practice grid or participate in this event.

RACING NOS. ALL race numbers will be White with Black numbers. Securely tape the race numbers provided using CLEAR tape on all three sides of your kart, namely front, left and right sides. A SPECIAL COLORED PANEL denoting Race & Class will be issued upon entry and should be affixed to the back panel of your kart. Remember, even though electronic scoring is being done, conventional back up scoring by race number will occur. For proper identification, be sure your numbers are correct and properly affixed to your kart.

## BKC Rules and Procedures at Road America

At the completion of each race, all karts must proceed to the scales for weigh-in even if you did not finish the race. NOTE: In order to receive points, ALL competitors MUST INITIAL their class entry sheet at the scales when they are weighed in.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A FINISHING POSITION, ANY KART IMPOUNDED BY A TECH OFFICIAL MUST SIGN THE TECH SHEET BEFORE LEAVING THE AREA.

Results will be announced and posted at the meeting trailer. Any scoring protest must be presented in writing within 60 minutes of the posting time. Any other protest must be presented at Registration within 60 minutes of completion of the race. Protest forms will be available in registration.

Awards will be given out 60 minutes after the official results have been posted at the trailer across from Registration. Participants are asked to remain at the site until all participants have received their awards so that a group picture can be taken.

NO ENGINE is to be started before 8:30 AM or after 5 PM on Friday. NO ENGINE is to be started before 8AM or after 6PM on Saturday and Sunday, Speed Limit on the grounds is TEN-MILES per hour.

Please use caution at all times.

ALL KARTS MUST ENTER THE TRACK VIA THE PIT ROAD. ABSOLUTELY NO DRIVING OF KARTS BEHIND THE PIT ROAD WALL. ANY INFRINGEMENT WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

THE SECURITY GUARDS ENFORCE RULES OF ROAD AMERICA. The back one- half of the track is open to all participants for VIEWING ONLY. Bicycles MUST BE WALKED IN THE PADDOCK AREA. There will be NO ROLLERBLADES or SKATEBOARDS ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY. Use of Motor Bikes, ATV's, ETC., ANYWHERE ON TRACK PROPERTY IS SUBJECT TO THE CONSIDERATION OF TRACK AND RACE OFFICIALS.

ALL PARTICIPANTS AND OFFICIALS MUST VACATE THE TRACK AND PADDOCK AREA BY 7 PM ON SUNDAY NIGHT.

To avoid conflict, confusion or disciplinary action, BE SURE to acquaint yourself with all the rules and procedures in this booklet.




