5. That any change in the insulin dosage administered to Ms. Jane Duchene was done pursuant to medical orders from Dr. Victor A. Corbett.

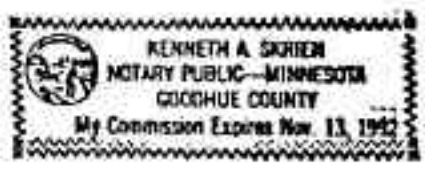
