Affiant Stanley N. Zahorsky, after being duly sworn upon oath, states and deposes as follows:

1. That he is the attorney for Mary Jane Duchene.
2. That on August 13, 1987 a deposition was taken of Ken Reichstadt, Dakota County Vulnerable Adults Social Worker.
3. During the said deposition Ken Reichstadt testified as follows:
 - a. After investigating the allegation that Mary Jane Duchene may have been illegally removing money from the country, he and West St. Paul Policeman Jeff Batezell concluded that there was no evidence of illegal activities, as alleged by the reporter.
 - b. Mary Jane Duchene did not physically abuse Jane D. Duchene.
 - c. When he visited the home of Jane D. Duchene, he observed it to be reasonably clean.
 - d. When he visited the home of Jane D. Duchene, he observed that the alleged locked cabinet containing the financial records of Jane D. Duchene was not locked, and while he was at the home, he observed others removing records from the cabinet.
 - e. He found no evidence that Mary Jane Duchene was denying Jane D. Duchene food and that Jane D. Duchene could walk without support and at the same pace as others.
