IF YOU PLAN TO:

- Buy property
- Clear property
- Develop property

- Remove underwater vegetation
- Remove emergent vegetation
- Drain/mow /fill wetlands
- Dig a deeper boat channel
- Build a boardwalk or raised pathway
- Change the appearance of the set-back by:
 - Clearing Cutting
 - Planting Grading
 - Filling
- Install any form of riprap
- Install a boat or dock lift
- Build or repair any small structure near the shore:
 - Boat house Gazebo
 - Storage locker

The Shoreland Management Ordinance of Beltrami County is designed to protect the quality of the waters of the county from degradation and pollution by regulating what can and cannot be done to property within 1,000 feet of the shoreline, particularly in the set-back or "impact zone".
