We have just received notice from Athletics Australia that the next round of grants (of up to \$500) from the R.W.Clarke Foundation close on 30 April. The foundation is used to assist young athletes (preferably under 23) to obtain competition at major domestic meets e.g. national championships, Grand Prix events. **Rohan Walker** obtained a grant last year.

Preference will be given (but not restricted to) those athletes not already receiving support from programs such as the ACT Academy of Sport.

Athletes should apply personally by hand writing their application and mailing it to Athletics Australia at Suite 22, Fawkner Towers, 431 St Kilda Rd, Melbourne, VIC 3004.

Athletes should apply for assistance to events conducted in the next few months - there will be no retrospective payments.
