SCHEDULE

We will begin with show #1 at 9 AM with Rebecca Doughty judging. The order of the show will be SHOWMANSHIP, WETHERS, UNREGISTERED DOES, NPGA DOES, UNREGISTERED BUCKS and then NPGA BUCKS. Show #2, with Carol Hepner judging, will follow Show 1 after a short lunch break. Show #3, will be judged by Shad Te Grotenhuis. Showmanship will be during the first show only. There will be a short club meeting during lunch.

SHOW RULES

NPGA rules will govern all NPGA classes. Per NPGA show rules, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to make sure that their animals are entered in the correct classes. *Please do not send in entry forms without class numbers listed for your goats*. Any NPGA animal over 6 months of age must be tattooed or microchipped prior to being shown in a sanctioned NPGA class or wether class according to NPGA show rules. All goats entered in the NPGA sanctioned classes must be accompanied by their NPGA registration certificates. Registered wethers should also have their registration certificates accompanying them. Unregistered wethers can be shown in the wether classes.

ENTRIES

Entry fees are \$8.00 per goat/per class payable to NCPGC. (No charge for showmanship.) *Entry deadline to be in the showbook is May 19, 2021*. Substitutions and late entries will not be included in the printed program, but are welcome. Age computation for classes is based on the age of the goat on the date of the show.

PENS

8 stalls (wood and stationary) that could be used for bucks on one side of barn. Six larger stalls (wood and stationary) that pens could be placed inside stall. Goats could slip under or climb out if not in a smaller pen. Shavings provided, no straw allowed. 20x80 center aisle that people could set up their own pens. Space would be first come basis. The barn can be locked at night if animals need to be kept in barn.

CHECK IN and ARRIVAL TIME

Check-in and arrival may begin Friday May 21 after 2 PM. Friday check in from 5 to 6 PM. Saturday check in from 7:30 to about 8:45 AM.

HEALTH PAPERS/RESTRICTIONS

Virginia import laws will apply. Most states require health papers for animals being brought in for sale or exhibition. Please check with your veterinarian or the NC state vet for regulations.

SPONSORSHIPS

We welcome any sponsorship of the classes in the show. You may sponsor any number of classes for \$5.00 each. You may wish to dedicate your sponsorship to a favorite goat, a special goat mentor, etc. You get a free business card ad in the showbook with each class sponsored.

ACCOMODATIONS

People with campers are allowed to stay on the grounds; no water or electricity hook-ups available. Bathrooms nearby for anyone staying there overnight.

MEALS

Lunch arrangements will be made closer to show time. Water and tea will also be provided. Please feel free to bring a dessert or side dish, get with Cathy Vaden to coordinate.

The outside pavilion is a great place to show our goats. There will be bleachers placed on the inside of the pavilion. This will not only serve as a place for people to sit, but also as a barrier for any goat that wants to try and get away. It is covered and has lights and a stage.
