

Phillip E. Frank, a 20 year old
Marine, who was killed in action in Iraq, on April 8, during
hostile fire in the Al Anbar
Province. We hear about the

was the son of my friends, Roy

and Georgette Frank. When it hits home, the loss seems greater and more personal. My heart goes out to my friends, but also to all of the families who have lost loved ones in the war. When Phillip witnessed the tragic disaster of 9/11, he decided to commit his life to the military, and serve

his country. The first words
