

Final Examination

Toward the end of the fifth session, the final exam will be given. Students will be given an hour to take it, and they may use an unmarked Bible to take it, if they so desire. It will be essay in format. As a general rule, students should plan on answers of 2-5 paragraphs, depending on the question. The essay questions will be chosen by instructor from the pool of questions below.

1. What is systematic theology and why is it important?
2. Describe and briefly defend the verbal-plenary inspiration and inerrancy of Scripture.
3. Describe and biblically defend the orthodox doctrine of the Trinity.
4. What is the Christian view of humanity?
5. Describe and biblically defend the orthodox Chalcedonian doctrine of the person of Christ.
6. Describe and biblically defend the penal-substitutionary atonement of Christ.
7. What is the gospel?
8. Compare Calvinism and Arminianism using the TULIP acronym.
9. What is the church?
