THE AUTHOR

Michael Aubrecht was born and raised in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. As a young boy, he developed a great interest in Civil War history following a family vacation to Gettysburg. Over the years, Michael continued to study the history of the War Between the States and routinely traveled to Civil War battlefields located both north and south of the Mason Dixon Line. After graduating from the Art Institute of Pittsburgh with a specialized degree in Visual Communications, Michael moved south to Fredericksburg, VA where he resides to this day.

Another passion of Michael's is the history of America's National Pastime and in 2000 he was hired as a freelance Sr. Writer for Baseball-Almanac.com. Since then, he has produced over 375+ separate studies and essays on the history of Major League Baseball and the New York Yankees. In 2004, Michael joined FaithWriters and began writing Christian-based material that has been published in multiple magazines and periodicals. Following an award-winning FaithWriters essay on Thomas Jackson, Michael began researching the possibility of writing an entire book on the subject.

The result was *Onward Christian Soldier: The Spiritual Journey of Stonewall*. A Christian-historical biography, the book presents an intimate portrait of Confederate General Thomas Jackson and a testament to the spiritual strength that he lived, and ultimately, died by. In 2004, Publish America signed Michael to produce the book as well as a companion volume entitled *Christian Cavalier: The Spiritual Legacy of J.E.B. Stuart*. Unlike the 1000+ page analytical studies that have come before them, these stories focus on the religious fervor that enabled these men to overcome great adversity with an unparalleled faith in both their God and country.

Both manuscripts have received wonderful support and praise by several experts including noted Civil War author Jeff Shaara, whose book *Gods and Generals* inspired the entire project to begin with. Several editors have also suggested that *Onward Christian Soldier* be added to Bible College "recommended reading" lists for students interested in studying the role of religion in the Civil War.
