Clandestine Warfare – Conter Insurgency

- I. The United States of America has a great military record despite the fact that they have given little attention to the military in all of our history.
 - A. The most instable and inefficient form of government is Democracy.
 - 1. When a maximum number of people decide what to do it is total confusion.
 - 2. The more people that have something to say about things the worse it is.
 - 3. If the running of the United States army depended on the opinion of everyone in the United States of America there would be total chaos.
 - 4. People in business cannot run an army as seen in the managerial system of leadership in place since the 1970's.
 - 5. People in science cannot run an army
 - B. We have a great system of military leadership because we had great men who were dedicated to the military.
 - 1. No large organization succeeds beyond the integrity and honor of the individuals who compose it.
 - 2. We have less understanding of honor and integrity in the officer corps than in all of the history of the United States of America
 - C. The problem is Self Righteous Arrogance and this resulted in our setting up an inflexible arrogant stupid code.
 - 1. Because of this we will never be able to gather information and neutralize the brains of the enemy.
 - 2. CIA was formed in 1945 to fight the KGB
 - 3. MI5 and MI6 were recruited from aristocrats and these men understood honor and integrity and were raised by it.
 - 4. These men understood you could maintain honor and integrity while doing dirty things in war.
 - 5. Today we rely too much on computers (1980) and it is much worse today and we depend too much on science and not enough on human beings.
 - D. The idea of killing and intimidating, using terror and lying and deceiving which are sin in normal times are not sin in time of war, revolution or civil war is unconscionable to us in the United States of America.
 - 1. It is just as honorable to fight behind the lines in the dirty war of clandestine warfare as it is in the front lines.
 - 2. It takes more to fight the clandestine war and the person must have integrity, honor and flexibility and objectivity personally since there is NOT Available the whole realm of people used to support conventional war for the clandestine warrior.
 - E. June 23 Time Magazine, Pg 39 KGB is watching every minute.
 - 1. KGB agents get the equivalent of Medals or Honor for proper clandestine function.
 - 2. The typical KGB agent is a man of PURE honesty, enormous personal courage, implacable in the struggle against enemies, stern in the name of duty, ready to sacrifice himself in the fight against his enemy.
 - 3. KGB fights us and the Russian citizens today it is the GRU I think.
 - 4. FBI is our internal security organization and CIA is our external security organization.
 - 5. When a person dirties his hands in intelligence and counter intelligence, sabotage etc he is honored.
 - 6. "The Wilderness of Mirrors" David C. Martin.
 - 7. In the United States of America we cannot distinguish between normal times and clandestine warfare times.
 - 8. In the intelligence community lying and deception are patriotic functions.
 - 9. Combat sanctions physical violence and espionage grants license to moral violence.
 - 10. Intelligence organization operatives cannot fear public examination but neither can they expect public honor.

- 11. The CIA in order to help the United States of America survive in the intelligence war must become more ruthless than the KGB.
- 12. The long standing concepts of fair play held in the United States of America must be abandoned in clandestine warfare function.
 - i. This was the recommendation of Jimmy Doolittle a great honorable NICE man.
- 13. While assassination and mail opening can be summarily banned and have been the secret war must remain devious and underhanded and deceptive as possible.
- 14. Loyalty demands dishonesty and deception and was a thieves game.
- 15. The United States of America has not discovered the secret to functioning in intelligence.
- F. You must have good intelligence organizations and also excellent counter insurgency functions to win any warfare effort.
 - 1. The military must never fail to recognize that their purpose is above all to maintain freedom and security of the people of this nation.
 - 2. Counter Insurgency is the function to destroy the action of the brains of the enemy.
- G. In counterinsurgency and clandestine warfare and in conventional warfare GOD will strike down the revolutionary IF the nation has a great enough pivot.
 - 1. God will use counter insurgency and conventional warfare both to defeat the revolutionaries.
 - 2. God will use the honorable believer who has enough Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul to recognize that clandestine war is just as honorable as conventional war.
 - 3. In our nation United States of America we barely tolerate conventional war and obviously are totally intolerant of clandestine warfare.
 - 4. It is just as honorable and patriotic to lie, cheat, steal, kill in clandestine war as it is to kill and capture and destroy the enemy in conventional war.
- H. When we evaluate clandestine war we must fall back on Bible Doctrine to be able to see it clearly.
 - 1. This type of war gives us the freedom to live normal lives without the functions needed to win in clandestine warfare.

I. Flexibility:

- 1. Demands that the home, clothing and lifetime of accumulated possessions be left behind and that you move out with what is in your soul to fight the civil war or revolution.
- 2. Every believer must have 2 scale of values and we must remember that our emergency equipment is not something we stash or hide but what we carry within us.
- 3. Our deliverance is the Metabolized Bible Doctrine in our Stream of Consciousness of the Soul.
- 4. When adversity comes you must recognize when to switch to adversity scale of values to weather the storm of civil war and revolution.
- 5. You have to have Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and must be flexible, but you cannot be flexible without being humble and you have to be objective and must have humility to be objective.
 - i. Humility is freedom from the Interlocking System of Arrogance
- 6. We must be able to apply the Essence of God, Plan of God and Logistical Grace rationales by abandoning all material blessings and shifting from the prosperity scale of values to the adversity scale of values
- 7. Prejudice produces inefficiency and it is stupidity and Self Righteous Arrogance in thought.
- 8. The function of counter insurgency requires becoming an great mole in the enemy ranks.
 - i. This is the most difficult thing to do in life to penetrate the highest level of enemy government and not be caught.
- 9. You cannot shift to an adversity scale of values unless you have one.
 - i. It must be in your thought process

- ii. You must have Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul to make it the content of your thoughts.
- iii. When we have personal problems we must use our doctrinal thought process and our Faith Rest Drill (4 categories) functions and make it operational.
- J. All mature believers possess HUMILITY, flexibility and objectivity from the Metabolized Bible Doctrine resources in their Stream of Consciousness of the Soul
 - 1. Changing circumstances do not change blessing from the Justice of God.
 - i. The blessing from the Justice of God is always compatible with the historical situation.
 - ii. Without reverse concentration of Faith Rest Drill _(4 categories) function the believer cannot adapt to his circumstances and cannot adapt his changing scale of values to the circumstance.
 - 2. People who are normally courageous in normal situations tend to be impulsive in disaster
 - i. An impulsive person becomes stupid in disaster
 - ii. As long as God gives you life and as long as you can think you must be FLEXIBLE.
 - iii. You may even have to cater to the revolutionaries with flexibility and humility in order to penetrate and infiltrate them and get more of them.
 - iv. Killing the low level soldiers is useless and when you can think and survive you can get to more important people in the revolution and take them out.
 - v. When God gives you life survival is the issue and you will get the enemy in the Plan of God just take your time and have patience.
- II. Great leadership is always sensitive about those in his periphery.
 - A. We must always think in terms of our circumstances and be Alert in regard to our current environment.
 - 1. We must learn to think in terms of your current circumstances.
 - 2. Any form of leadership or social life or honorable living demands that you take cognizance of your circumstances and be alert to what should be said or done.
 - B. To be able to function properly in intelligence and counter intelligence and counter insurgency especially:
 - 1. You must be able to appear stupid or naive when incredibly smart.
 - 2. Arrogant people are impressed by sincerity.
 - 3. If arrogant people are impressed by sincerity the means of getting to arrogant people is to appear very very sincere.
 - C. Counter insurgency requires the greatest courage and greatest flexibility and objectivity.
 - 1. There are not written rules for counter intelligence nor for counter insurgency.
 - 2. You have to be very very intelligent and very courageous and have great integrity in counter intelligence and counter insurgency.
- III. The format for intrigue:
 - A. It involves LYING
 - B. Lying and deceit is the strategic environment for counter insurgency.
 - C. At best counter insurgency is dirty work involving:
 - 1. Murder
 - 2. Lying
 - 3. Deceit
 - 4. Exploitation of EVERY HUMAN weakness and vanity to neutralize enemy strengths.
 - D. Therefore counter insurgency is a contradiction of characteristics in the operative requiring:
 - 1. On the one hand Loyalty, moral courage, integrity, humility and flexibility.
 - 2. On the other hand lying intrigue, deceit and total ruthlessness.
 - E. The contradiction of prerequisites often involves the danger of becoming a double agent.
 - 1. The counter insurgent has his own area where he can be destroyed if discovered.
 - 2. Thus if the enemy discovers these they can be used to convert a counter insurgent to a

double agent.

- F. To avoid becoming a double agent and traitor to his country the intelligence and counter intelligence agent must have above all integrity and honor.
 - 1. Thus the believer with maximum Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul is the best qualified person for this work.
 - 2. The greater the integrity the more objective you are in the function of ruthlessness.
- G. Insurgency == Revolution thus counter revolutionary activity which deceives and sabotages the leadership or intelligence of the revolution is counter insurgency.
- H. Counter insurgency can take the form of:
 - 1. Violence
 - 2. Murder
 - 3. Assassination
 - 4. Intimidation
 - 5. Despite all of this the counter insurgent must maintain his integrity and honor.
 - 6. Also Ruse and Duplicity to neutralize the counsel of a revolutionary leader.
 - 7. And the greatest functions occurred in the middle ages when Ghengis Khan had such an organization.
 - i. He was the greatest in this function of intimidation and would kill thousands and display them to intimidate those who wanted to fight him.
 - ii. This system applies very well to criminal activity and how to control it.
- I. Wilderness of Mirrors, David C Martin
 - 1. Our great weakness in the United States of America is that we play the game fairly
 - i. This is focused on conventional war and should not be used in intelligence functions.
 - 2. This is based on the Interlocking System of Arrogance functions of our own citizens and leaders.
 - 3. Arrogance produces Self Righteous Arrogance and has only one standard it is totally inflexible.
- J. War in the Shadows, Robert Aspery
 - 1. You lose wars because of arrogance in the people.
 - 2. So long as peasants remain apathetic and hostile the military effort against the guerrillas could never succeed no matter how expansive it would become.
 - i. Viet Nam
 - 3. The formula for disaster in combat is Arrogance of Ignorance combined with the arrogance of power.
 - 4. Failure of any combat unit against guerrilla warfare is found in the arrogance of ignorance.
 - 5. Complexities of insurgency must be understood to be able to fight against guerrillas.
 - 6. Intelligence organizations MUST bring accurate information into play to solve the combat problems and it must use counter insurgency.
 - 7. Arrogance of ignorance when it comes to the front will destroy rational thought.
 - 8. There must be careful target selection and in insurgency or revolution if you provide many targets for the insurgents it will spread them thinly and enable easy destruction of individual units.
 - 9. Saturation of a battle area by the military will damage property and crops and even kill innocent people and thus alienate further the people providing comfort and support for the enemy.
 - 10. We must have alternate standards for fighting war in either conventional or clandestine systems.
 - 11. Quiet areas militarily in this type of conflict are not conquered but hot bets of political activity and must have counter insurgency and counter intelligence operations functioning in them constantly.

- 12. This book is an objective view on what happened in Vietnam, he said we were fighting with only one standard a conventional warfare standard.
 - i. He have destroyed our counter insurgency capabilities.

K. Principles:

- 1. We must have the sense to operate under dual standards:
 - i. One for conventional warfare and one for clandestine warfare.
 - ii. Both have equal honor and when a person has this understanding they are the greatest leaders in history.
 - iii. You cannot qualify for greatness in Human History without having the function of genius in both system standards
- 2. The arrogance of the United States of America is arrogance of ignorance combined with arrogance of power can only except one standard for conventional warfare and we apply it to all conflict.
- 3. For this reason we are constantly defeated by the communists in clandestine war.
 - i. Communists encourage ruthlessness and are evil as seen by their use of ruthlessness in conventional warfare.
 - ii. There is no excuse for this ruthlessness in conventional warfare.
 - iii. We must recognize that HONOR belongs in the drawing room and in your personal life but if you are out to get an enemy anything goes.
- 4. The arrogance of ignorance plus the arrogance of power have combined to destroy our humility and flexibility needed to be successful in secret service work.
- 5. Intelligence, counter intelligence and counter insurgency demand humility of knowledge combined with humility of power to establish norms and standards for success in this field of warfare.
- 6. God used counter insurgency and all of its functions to win the intelligence victory of the civil war, **2Sam 17:14**
- L. To be great in the nasty field of intelligence you must combine:
 - 1. Integrity and honor with lying, deceit, bribing, fabrication, the facade of stupidity and exploitation of the weakness and vanity of others.

IV. Intelligence Operations:

- A. Communication with field operatives must be up to the hour or minute.
- B. Flexibility of planning and execution is essential for any intelligence operation.
- C. The field commander MUST BE in command and not rely on others who are a great distance away to make decisions.
 - 1. Civilian leadership must stay out of decision making in the field.
- D. There must be a plan and several backup plans for any operation.
- E. All operations must be considered LIFE and DEATH.
- F. The United States of America is not equipped for unconventional warfare, clandestine warfare.
 - 1. The United States of America does not understand that you cannot fight terrorism with clean hands.
 - 2. The basic keys to success are flexibility, deviousness, and all the elements of inspired madness.
- G. It is acceptable to ask the intelligence agent to lie, cheat, steal, commit all types of actions considered sins in normal times requires understanding the necessity for 2 scale of values when involved in any type of war especially clandestine war.
 - 1. These men must use fabrication and deception to deceive the enemy at high levels of operation.
- H. In any revolution in Human History it is always based on false propaganda, fabrication, lies delivered to the people in general who are under strong delusion making people believe the lie.
 - 1. Since the revolutionists believe the lie under strong delusion GOD will judge and destroy them under the same principle of strong delusion.
 - 2. The counter insurgent must be able to plant a better lie on the liars of the revolution and

- destroy them.
- 3. A Lie in the mouth of an honorable man will destroy the liars.
- 4. The revolutionists or any others who live by the lie will die by the lie.
- 5. In conventional war and criminality those who live by violence will be destroyed by greater violence.
- I. Revolution rejects truth and accepts lies and will be defeated by their own weapon lying and deceit
 - 1. They are arrogant and are vulnerable to be defeated in any system which uses greater arrogance and will be ruined by arrogance, inflexibility and subjectivity.
 - 2. There is strength in humility and weakness in arrogance.
 - 3. Arrogance creates is own system of destruction so that those in the Interlocking System of Arrogance destroy themselves
 - i. Those outside sources and people who are against the arrogant are not the downfall of the arrogant
 - ii. Those who are arrogant destroy themselves and no one outside of themselves are the cause of their downfall.

J. Principle:

- 1. Consequently the counter insurgent will defeat the arrogant revolutionist through shifting to a new scale of values
 - i. This scale of values and system of integrity walks the narrow line between victory and freedom through intelligence Modus Operandi and the function of what ordinarily would be criminality and traitorship.
- 2. Arrogance gives people tunnel vision in terms of counter insurgency and terrorism.
 - i. This is seen in our system of execution of criminals which actually does not exist.
 - ii. They should be publicly executed by drawing and quartering and their family and neighbors made to walk between the parts.
 - iii. We have tunnel vision with regard to criminality which has caused a rise in crime.
 - iv. We have that same tunnel vision when viewing the dirty work of counter insurgency and terrorism.
 - v. We are arrogant, thus vulnerable and weak.
 - vi. The Russians never invaded because the KGB has infiltrated every aspect of American society and see no reason to function on the battlefield when they can take over through intelligence operations.
- 3. God thus uses the wrath of man to praise him. PS 76:10
 - i. God uses counter insurgency to punish client nations
 - ii. God uses it to destroy evil nations as well.
- 4. This illustrates the principle of James 4:6, and 1Pet 5:5
- 5. Counter insurgency is war against the arrogant.
 - i. Revolution is constructed on arrogance and falsehood and it is destroyed through humility and truth.
- 6. The enemies best weapon must be turned against himself by defeating him at the most vulnerable point of weakness.
 - i. Arrogance destroys arrogance; Lies destroy lies and thus intelligence war and counter insurgency is the major contributor to winning on the battlefield in any civil war which follows.
- K. You cannot have counter insurgency as a function by itself
 - 1. It must have support and all aspects of clandestine warfare depend on other aspects of clandestine warfare.
 - i. There must be intelligence agents, double agents, counter insurgency agents, anti terrorist agents, counter terrorism agents, etc and they must all work together.

L. Principles:

1. There are no accidents in the life of the believer and Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ

controls Human History.

- 2. Those who live by the lie die by the lie.
 - i. In arrogance man creates his own system of destruction.
 - ii. The revolution and civil war to come will ultimately destroy the leaders and followers all in the Interlocking System of Arrogance
- V. The Honorable Spy and Counter Insurgent.
 - A. A lie told by a very very honorable man is difficult in that he must make it believable.
 - 1. When an honorable person does a difficult thing which is not wrong but appears so he does a better job at it than a dishonorable person.
 - 2. No one can lie better than an honorable person in the functions of counter intelligence or counter insurgency.
 - B. A habitual liar is a terrible liar and his lying is normal living but for an honorable man lying is not normal.
 - 1. To make the lie believable the honorable man must have an alternate scale of values which comes into play in this abnormal situation.
 - 2. He lies and deceives not as sin but as a great patriot and man, and under blessing from God.
 - 3. He is fulfilling the principle that the Arrogant are Weak and whatever the natural strength of the arrogant, arrogance is weakness.
 - C. The Mole is a secret agent of one country whose objective is to infiltrate the highest echelon of another country in order to gain secret information and plant false information and neutralize genius in the command of the country they infiltrate by intimidation and blackmail, violence etc.
 - 1. He is often a citizen of the country who he is infiltrating.
 - i. Colleges (Cambridge) are great places for recruitment of spies for enemy countries.
 - D. Arrogant people tend toward pettiness.
 - 1. When a man becomes arrogant and stays that way very long he takes on the feminine quality of vulnerability to flattery and pettiness.
 - E. When an arrogant person interrogates someone he is not flexible but vulnerable to flattery and to his own failure of pettiness in the Interlocking System of Arrogance
 - 1. Pettiness is looking for someone to reduce to a state of crawling for recognition to stimulate his arrogance.
 - 2. Arrogance produces incompetence even where there is ability for competence.
 - 3. Prejudice guarantees incompetence and it is the thinking of arrogance.
 - F. In order to be devious you must be flexible.
 - 1. If you are arrogant you are inflexible.
 - 2. The deviousness of arrogance is failure.
 - 3. Flexibility maintains honor and integrity while doing the dirty work of counter insurgency.
 - 4. When those on the top echelon in intelligence organizations are arrogant they neutralize their own ability and that of the agents below them.

VI. Application:

- A. The United States of America has not learned that we cannot fight terrorism and evil without clandestine warfare
 - 1. As long as we in the United States of America remain in Interlocking System of Arrogance we will never know this truth.
- B. Political arrogance in the United States of America is combined with the arrogance of ignorance to guarantee the coming disaster in this nation.
 - 1. Vietnam has not real strategic necessity for the United States of America and by identification with the French in Vietnam and then the government of South Vietnam we made 2 mistakes.
 - 2. God chose to punish the people of Vietnam and their system of idolatry and demonism

- which was over due for punishment.
- 3. All the suffering which has gone on in South East Asia and has gone on without restraint forces the conclusion that God is punishing a whole segment of the world.
- 4. The people of south east Asia have rejected truth from missionaries for a long time.
- 5. It is an area of great demonism and God used the communists to punish these people as he did the people of china.
- 6. When we went to Vietnam we interfered with Divine Discipline of that region of the world just as Gossip and Maligning interferes with Divine Discipline for individuals.
- C. The second mistake was the misuse of our military establishment once committed and our use of systems brought in from other wars and non functional in jungle warfare which would not work.
 - 1. This was guerrilla warfare and it needed to be fought with a similar system of destruction.
 - 2. You must use the same type of flexible movement just as the British in Malaya under Winston Churchill's dual system of function allowing British officers to move into an area and use torture to get what was needed to find the enemy.
 - 3. We in the United States of America don't know how to fight a war and be ruthless and still be honorable.
 - 4. See the British handling the communists in Malaya.
 - 5. So many places we go to fight for "freedom" we are going to places where God is punishing the people for rejection of truth as in Korea where presbyterian missionaries had done a fantastic job.
 - 6. God thus clobbered the Koreans and we of course got into the way with our Self Righteous Arrogance.
- D. This ARROGANCE has made our policies stupid and we have failed to keep touch with spiritual thinking.
 - 1. We must never go in to defend a people whom God has decided to destroy.
 - 2. All we have to look at is where the missionaries have gone and what the response was to the truth.
 - 3. God always punishes for rejection of the truth of Laws of Divine Establishment and Doctrine.
 - 4. We should have recognized the honorable allies in Taiwan, and in South Africa, and Samosa and Shaw of Iran, etc.
- E. We in the United States of America are locked into Self Righteous Arrogance and crusader arrogance.
 - 1. Both or foreign policy and domestic policies reflect our Self Righteous Arrogance and Crusader Arrogance which has developed since 1945 and WE WILL BE JUDGED FOR IT
 - 2. WE MUST develop an emergency scale of values and get into humility to be used of the Lord in time of national disaster.
 - 3. We have been interfering with God's judgment of other people throughout our recent history.
 - 4. From the standpoint of Bible Doctrine and this passage of 2Sam the more it looks like the United States of America will never survive unless Americans will be killed by the millions and then hopefully we will have to have our faces pushed into the dust and finally recognize our huge arrogance.
 - 5. Maybe just maybe in grace God will see fit to honor the existence of a small pivot of believers and others who will come to their senses and allow us to continue under the Grace of God.
 - 6. The Justice of God will, and today in 2013, is giving us the most shocking events we have ever imagined.
- VII. Political arrogance and general arrogance has increased in the United States of America to the point that we cannot any longer blame our leaders for our problems but must blame ourselves and we must recognize that Interlocking System of Arrogance have changed Americans.

- A. Interlocking System of Arrogance has made an incredible difference in the citizenship of the United States of America
 - 1. There is arrogance in every facet of American life
 - 2. As disaster occurs we will see more and more people blame the president and congress and any form of government, national, state, or local.
 - 3. Elected representatives whom we blame are still elected by us and if we blame one whom we voted for we are the coward.
- B. We have elected to government men who are inadequate for disaster.
 - 1. The real problem is that Interlocking System of Arrogance is so prominent today that the people of this country are not ready for disaster.
- C. We have such poor leadership in high echelons of both political and military organizations all who are functioning in the Interlocking System of Arrogance and they are getting worse since the president is sifting out those who are devoted to the constitution.
 - 1. We must remain in the ranks of the pivot believers the only remaining stabilizer of the nation.
- VIII. Vietnam was our chance to develop and refine the functions of clandestine warfare and organize the type of military needed to defeat communism anywhere.
 - A. We could have developed using Vietnam as a perfect field exercise our forces into an entirely new concept which would have kept terror off the streets and kept hyjacking of planes to nothing and put criminals where they belong into the ground.
 - 1. We could have had a system that can defeat communism
 - B. We should have organized schools to learn sabatoge and espionage, infiltration, hit and run guerrilla tactics, deception, torture, dirty warfare, killing key personnel, etc.
 - 1. It was done but never organized into a system and still there is no system and no policy.
 - C. Winning in direct confrontation of the enemy is way too expensive in both material and personnel
 - 1. We must learn to defeat communism through clandestine warfare and use the strategies of deception, lies, blackmail, intimidation, assassination, etc.
 - 2. This is the same principle by which we the client nation to God must fulfill the function of world wide missionary effort.
 - i. Missionaries must evangelize natives and train them to reach their own.
 - ii. This is how our military must be developed.
 - D. We must function in clandestine warfare and then train the natives to go back and counter attack communism.
 - 1. We should have brought Koreans and Vietnamese and Germans and Poles to the United States of America to train them and send them back to counter attack the communists.
 - 2. We have been looking through the glasses of arrogance of ignorance.
 - 3. Indigenous strategy is the secret to success in fighting communism.
 - 4. Just as the natives must learn to evangelize and teach Bible Doctrine to their own people so when their freedom is treatened they must learn to combat the evils present by clandestine warfare principles.
 - 5. We must train the people of a country to fight for their own country and freedom.
 - 6. If we had picked out 50,000 South Vietnamese and trained and equipped them and sent them back to fight communism.
 - E. Indigenous clandestine warfare is the secret to destruction of communism.
 - 1. We tried to convert the Vietnamese into American soldier lookalikes instead of converting them to communist lookalikes and sending them back to fight their true enemies.
 - F. In revolution the Lord and People are NEVER on the same side.
 - 1. Revolutionaries are anti doctrine, anti establishment and under strong delusion and accept the propaganda of revolution.
 - 2. The revolutionaries are best described by involvement with Interlocking System of Arrogance and strong delusion from Negative Volition to Bible Doctrine

- G. Arrogance is weak and vulnerable to deception
 - 1. Any deceptive approach which complements the arrogant the arrogant is vulnerable to.
 - 2. The flattery of deception overcomes and defeats the arrogance of ignorance in revolution.
 - 3. We see a demonstration dramatically the ineffectiveness of public opinion where Interlocking System of Arrogance combine with strong delusion to convert the fabrication of revolutionary propaganda into violence and evil.
 - 4. The revolution can be a success when arrogance and strong delusion saturates the officer corps of the army causing them to follow the revolutionaries.
 - 5. The only defense against strong delusion and revolutionary propaganda is ABSOLUTE TRUTH of the Laws of Divine Establishment and Bible Doctrine.
- H. If we are to win against the revolution in the United States of America today in 2013 we must begin to fight with these principles of clandestine warfare against the insidious destruction of our constitution and federal government by liberal socialism in our nation.
 - 1. They are doing just this.
- IX. The flattery of deception always succeeds against the arrogance of ignorance.
 - A. Principle:
 - 1. If you have arrogance with ability, genius or talent you are weak instead of strong.
 - 2. Once you accept the system of arrogance it is the end for you since arrogance will destroy all your ability, genius and talent.
 - 3. The best lie always have the environment of truth attached to them.
 - 4. The person to whom you lie will pick up the true part and assume that the whole thing is truth.
 - i. This is counter insurgency.
 - 5. The counter insurgent lying must be noble and honorable use lies and deception and exploit the weakness of the enemy.
 - i. He must gain the confidence of the leader of the revolution and is doing it legitimately.
 - ii. These are not lies of patriotism which are honorable and do not have to be confessed.
 - iii. One system of attack is based on the principle of the Voice of the People is the voice of God. Vocs Populii Vocs Dei
 - a. This is a FALSE principle found at least 800 years before the romans and used in counter insurgency.
 - B. All republics tend to become arrogant and degenerate and become democracies
 - 1. The weakness of the republic is the assumption that because of past success and greatness we are still great.
 - i. When hooked to arrogance we become vulnerable to the concept of Vocs Populii Vocs Dei.
 - ii. This is one of the oldest systems for the exploitation of weakness that exists.
 - iii. There is only one thing more nauseating that a person exploiting arrogance in an individual is one exploiting the arrogance of a group.
 - 2. The truth of the principle is found in Vocs Et Pritea Nihil , It is a voice and nothing else.
 - C. Principle:
 - 1. You have to be arrogant, reversionistic and under strong delusion to be impressed by Self Righteous Arrogance.
 - i. Arrogant people are the only ones impressed by Self Righteous Arrogance
 - 2. The majority of the people in the United States of America today are in the Interlocking System of Arrogance and the only thing which impresses them is Self Righteous Arrogance.
 - i. A country is like a social party which destroys itself when it becomes impressed with Self Righteous Arrogance
 - ii. The more we become impressed with Self Righteous Arrogance the more we are

impressed with self the more we neglect the military then the policy changes from spending money on recruiting not training.

- 3. We have national weakness in the national Self Righteous Arrogance.
 - i. In the United States of America the Self Righteous Arrogance of liberalism which says the downtrodden are as good as all of us is crusader arrogance.
- D. In counter insurgency the principle is to use anything to gain confidence of the leaders of the revolution in order to get close enough to destroy them.
 - 1. The Best liars use truth to start their lies and the arrogant person hearing the truth believes all of the lie as well.
 - i. This is destroying the enemy by clandestine warfare and by telling truth and mixing it with lies the counter insurgent must convince the revolutionary leader that he is loyal.
- E. Doolittle's report to Eisenhower 1954.
 - 1. The Russians were already winning the clandestine war only 9 years after World War II.
 - 2. Because the United States of America is new at the game of clandestine war and because we are facing police states where their system has been in use for many many years we are receiving information which is very short of our needs in intelligence.
 - 3. He recommended:
 - i. Exploration of every possible scientific avenue of approach the tunnel under the berlin wall was one such idea.
 - ii. Intensification of counter intelligence to prevent or detect or eliminate the penetrations of the CIA
 - iii. He urged the CIA to become more ruthless than the KGB.
 - 4. He understood that we could not win the war by using long standing systems of fair play.
 - i. We must learn to subvert, sabotage, to destroy the enemies by more clever and sophisticated methods than those used against us.
 - 5. We have not followed this report at all.

F. Principle:

- 1. Behind most revolutions and conspiracies is ONE smart person and as long as the revolutionaries or conspirators listen to him things go well but if he is lost the revolution is destroyed.
- 2. The trouble of a humble man serving the arrogant leader is that he eventually assumes that he did it all and that he does not need the humble man.
- 3. No matter how much Bible Doctrine you have learned if you walk into Interlocking System of Arrogance you become instantly stupid.
- 4. You cannot use any doctrine learned with in the Interlocking System of Arrogance.
- 5. The secret to greatness is humility and the secret to destruction of greatness is arrogance.
- 6. This country has greatness potential with is fantastic but we have produced very few great men in history because of our national arrogance.
- G. Arrogant people cannot use their own talent or ability to get through life they must depend on others because vanity has destroyed or neutralized their positive assets.
 - 1. The further one gets from Laws of Divine Establishment authority the more difficult it is to determine what to do and since revolution starts with violence they go back to violence and a reign of terror results.
 - 2. Revolutions are easy to start but difficult to perpetuate
 - 3. When perpetuated by violence they inevitably fail or to survive they revert to Laws of Divine Establishment Modus Operandi.
 - 4. In time of pressure and adversity the Arrogant are Helpless.
 - 5. If you find yourself helpless in time of personal problems it is because of arrogance.
 - 6. Arrogant must depend on counsel and wisdom of others who are in humility.

X. Principle:

A. All freedom comes through military victory.

- 1. This principle is generally ignored throughout history.
- B. Victory in thinking precedes victory in battle.
 - 1. This applies to military functions and also in most areas of life.
 - 2. Success in planning and thinking brings success in business.
- C. A Mole is an agent of one country whose objective is to infiltrate the organizations of another country in order to gain secret information, plant false information, neutralize genius by intimidation, blackmail, or violence resulting in destruction of any effective or competent leadership in that nation.
- D. Arrogance neutralizes the ability and talent of any leader and can be exploited and used by any mole to his destruction.
- E. Political arrogance in the United States of America combined with the arrogance of ignorance and is what is bringing our nation to the great disaster we are about to experience.
 - 1. We have failed in military function especially in our inability to recognize the necessity of ruthlessness in clandestine warfare and even conventional warfare.
 - 2. We have received warning discipline repeatedly in the United States of America and are now in for extreme discipline.
 - 3. In the United States of America we have ONE standard for fighting war, that is a high moral standard and this puts us into violation of biblical principles.
 - 4. The primary principle is that in fighting war we need 2 standards of operation, one for normal daily functions and one for warfare especially clandestine warfare.
 - 5. While in conventional war robbing and stealing from helpless citizens is evil and unlawful in clandestine warfare everything goes including deception, intimidation, torture, and killing key personnel is NOT SIN but in fact honorable.
- F. Winning in direct confrontation with the enemy since 1945 is way too expensive and we must learn from communism the means of using clandestine warfare effectively.
 - 1. We must learn to organize the indigenous population to function in clandestine warfare against the enemies of a nation JUST AS indigenous application in missionary function is to be used to evangelize the people of a nation..
 - 2. Since we have failed in missionary function it is obvious that our standards are limited by ignorance of Bible Doctrine thus we also have failed in clandestine warfare since again our standards are limited by ignorance of Bible Doctrine.
 - 3. Natives must be trained to fight for their own freedom and this requires first the function of clandestine warfare through counter intelligence and counter insurgency agents who must train the indigenous population.
 - 4. This still applies here in the United States of America even though the people will be fighting the people and against the control of the federal government.
- G. When people choose revolution over establishment leadership it dramatizes the ineffectiveness of public opinion:
 - 1. Interlocking System of Arrogance combines with strong delusion to convert the fabrication of revolutionary propaganda into violence and evil.
 - 2. Revolution cannot divorce itself from violence.
 - 3. The failure of revolution is seen in the FACT that they MUST use violence against opposition and they cannot reason with opposition but MUST use violence.
 - 4. We MUST ALWAYS REMEMBER that the voice of the people in the general population is generally just a voice and is definitely not part of the Plan of God.
 - 5. The general population is susceptible to propaganda and deception from revolutionary leaders and cannot know or be part of the plan of God being saturated with arrogance resulting in strong delusion and believing the lies of revolutionary propaganda at face value.
 - 6. The general population when saturated with arrogance does not comprehend the divine nature of the Laws of Divine Establishment and the necessity for their continued function in order to maintain human freedom and easily fall prey to the arrogance of socialism and

communism propaganda.

- XI. In the United States of America in 1980 we have the same situation that occurred in france at the time of their revolution.
 - A. We have infiltration of peoples which are not American from Vietnam, Korea, China, Middle East, Mexicans, etc which are degrading the status of this country.
 - B. During the revolution here in the United States of America has been organized to use all these People in a very organized system to cause a forced change in this government.
 - C. Violence will be part of it, and there is huge difference in the level of violence which any one person can engage in.

XII. Principle:

- A. Advice in revolution when distorted by lust for power and revenge will fail.
 - 1. When it is done to start a reign of terror it will eventually fail.
 - 2. The advice must not be incompatible with common sense
 - 3. When you lose control of the people whom you lead you have lost whatever your cause represents.
 - i. There can be no qualms about shooting a deserter who runs away nor a rapist or one who stole or tortured civilians during military action.
 - a. These are all executable offenses
 - ii. Criminality in the military is unacceptable
 - iii. The greater the cause the Greater the Discipline and the greater the order which must be maintained.
 - 4. Revolutions which break down into reigns of terror go backward.
 - i. You must be able to control all those people under you when in leadership positions.
 - 5. Big Business MUST control those working for it and when labor controls a business the quality of the product and of the business is destroyed.
 - i. Organized Labor control labor and when management and the investor do not control labor it is finished for that business.
 - ii. When legitimate authority no longer controls its responsibility whatever its purpose has been is finished.
 - iii. The elected representatives of the United States of America do not control the federal government, not the president nor congress
 - iv. The bureaucracies are what are in control of the government.
 - v. When bureaucracy controls it guarantees inefficiency and it takes 100 people to do what one smart person can do.
 - vi. Bureaucracies answer to no one and are like small kingdoms functioning for themselves.
 - 6. Privacy is the most important thing in a functional society.
 - i. Gossip and Maligning is exactly like revolution
 - ii. It is rejection of the authority of the principles of God.
 - iii. The general trend of society today is to write Memiors and make them as evil as possible by gossiping about everyone.
 - iv. The whole concept of an evil society is sharing gossip and exposing your private life before the world.
 - v. This is contrary to privacy and freedom.
 - 7. A revolutionary army's lust for violence when indulged against the helpless population will bring destruction to it.
 - 8. During a reign of terror when the revolutionary army will rape, steal, murder and do whatever they wanted against the helpless population they set themselves up for defeat.
 - i. Thus when they go into battle they have lost the character needed for courage in combat.
 - ii. They will become cowards and be defeated and in fact actually lost the field

- battles when they went against the helpless people in the civilian population.
- iii. They will be objects of divine judgment through the principle that a pillaging and unrestrained army is a defeated army.
- 9. Once the revolution comes there is no police and no Law Enforcement agency to protect the freedom, privacy, property and lives of the law abiding citizens in the client nation.
 - i. It takes great character, honor and integrity to remain in Law Enforcement in the times we have today.
 - ii. When the day comes when the people call for the men in Law Enforcement and they will not be there and that will be revolution.
 - iii. Our judicial system is magnificent but the judges themselves are often very corrupt and without honor of any kind.
 - iv. In any city with a black administrator the Law Enforcement personnel have the most difficult time in trying to maintain their integrity and function.
 - v. Under black administration the Law Enforcement personnel have maximum pressure to function properly.
- B. Before the conventional war can be won on the battlefield clandestine operations must be successful in the staff of the revolutionaries.

XIII. Counter Insurgency

- A. Whenever race rears its head as an ugly issue it does so because the ones involved are in arrogance.
 - 1. History must be understood by flexibility and humility and objectivity.
 - 2. Whenever a group of people take themselves seriously, and pushing themselves and demanding for themselves as a race you are looking at arrogance.
 - 3. The race which makes an issue of self out of race is in arrogance and ready to be exploited by revolution.
 - 4. This is seen in the brown and black community from the 60's till now and is arrogance.
 - 5. To make an issue of race under our constitution and to demand right which are not earned nor deserved nor worked for and to claim discrimination this is arrogance and also CANNON FODDER for exploitation into revolution.
 - 6. This is also true of white trash but they don't know antecedents and thus cannot make issue of race.
 - 7. Many revolutions are started based on race or revolution:
 - i. Muslims start revolutions on the basis of religion
 - ii. They demanded their rights in India and got them and at least 1,000,000 muslims died within 30 days.
 - 8. Race and religion are exploited by revolution and people are arrogant about both.
 - 9. Once arrogance is added to race or religion the first loud mouthed rabble rouser will bring you to your destruction.
 - 10. When we go to war in the United States of America within our borders there will be race rioting and revolution.
 - i. There are constant claims for discrimination but this is arrogance and inflexibility.
 - 11. If a nation maintains itself it must meet the violence of revolution whether the cause is religion or race with greater violence and destroy it.
 - i. In the destruction many innocent people get hurt.
 - i. From the point of the Justice of God God uses revolution to punish many people.
 - 12. Whatever capabilities and ability a group may have in revolution they are neutralized by arrogance.
 - 13. The United States of America since the 60's has suffered as a whole nation in arrogance and we are waiting as a flash pan of powder for someone to drop a match into it to set it off.
 - 14. We are set for revolution and have lost the ability to laugh at ourselves and have no objectivity nor flexibility nor humility.

- 15. People who work hard and have integrity and honor never have trouble finding a job and advancement.
- 16. It is the arrogant who sits back and screams discrimination who has no ability nor integrity to advance in any system business or profession.
- 17. Hard work and sense of responsibility and advance to Spiritual Maturity is always respected.

XIV. Success of counter insurgency.

A. Principle:

- 1. Any plan for battle must include a provision for pursuit, exploitation and assassination.
- 2. It is always best when possible and confronting a competent enemy to plan for overkill to defeat his brilliance in battle.
- 3. Every moment that a good leader is free to function gives him more advantage and neutralizes the revolutions superior force and initial victories.

B. Principle:

- 1. Victory is never complete until there is pursuit and destruction of the enemy is completed.
- 2. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History and will preserve the mature believer with Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul.
- 3. The believer in counter intelligence and functioning in counter insurgency under Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ can and should use lying deceit and sabotage even murder if needed to destroy the plan of the revolution.

C. Principle:

- 1. Thinking is exhausting
 - i. It requires more energy to think than to exercise and thinking is the key to success in battle.
 - ii. To concentrate for a prolonged period of time is much more exhausting than exercise.
 - iii. Concentration on Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul will bring success in battle and defeat to the enemy.
- 2. The key to success for revolution is the death potentially great leaders.
 - Great numerical and material superiority through any war will not effect the outcome as long as the believer remains loyal to Bible Doctrine and Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ
 - ii. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History.
- 3. Revolutionary leaders ALWAYS under estimate the power of Bible Doctrine and the fact that Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History
 - i. Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul AND The pivot of mature believers when in opposition to revolution will always prevail.
 - ii. Revolutionary leaders always ignore the concept of the pivot.
 - iii. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History and will preserve the pivot of believers
 - iv. Establishment leaders must have a dynamic use of Bible Doctrine in reverse concentration of faith under pressure.
 - v. For the mature believer the greater the pressure the greater the ability to concentrate with Bible Doctrine and the greater the use of the rationales.
 - vi. The more pressure you put on the mature believer the greater his use of Bible Doctrine and thus the greater the success of the establishment army.
- 4. Proper Mental Attitude is seen in PS 61-2-3-4 and 25
 - i. The Battle for the mature believer is the Lord's.
- 5. For revolution to be a success and perpetuated mature believers must be eliminated.
- 6. The violence of the revolution will only intimidate a segment of the people, those who won't oppose the revolution anyway.

i. It will cause a reaction and when that reaction occurs under the leadership of a mature believer there will be no revolution left it will be wiped out.

XV. Terrorist Books

- A. "The Terrorists their weapons leaders and tactics" Dobson and Paine
 - 1. Terror is the key to revolution which is insurgency.
 - 2. They try to make murders heros and convince the public their cause is good.
 - 3. Idealists (Crusaders) + Criminals + Psychopaths all under the influence of political thinkers who preach that violence is needed to make the world better for the masses.
 - 4. Their thinking is that colonialism is wrong when in fact it was one of the greatest things to happen in the world bringing great evangelism and missionary functions to 3rd world nations.
 - 5. The new terrorists derived their motivation from the psychology of regaining self esteem as taught by fannin.
- B. "Blood Brains and Beer" David Ogleby
 - 1. He served in counter insurgency and intelligence for the British in World War II.
 - 2. Stalin started clandestine warfare while we were delivering billions of tons of military supplies to them in WWII.
 - 3. Even in WW II the American press put freedom of press before national security.

XVI. Counter Insurgency continued:

- A. If you are going on a special raid always over prepare for overkill.
 - 1. Concentration at the point of attack with the greatest number gives the greatest chance of success.
- B. The criminal aspect of the revolution wants only to rape and steal and have a good time in terror and let the revolution wait.
- C. Criminality in revolution gives counter attack great opportunity.
 - 1. After revolution has put down whatever is law and order in establishment the revolution goes berserk and they as criminals want steal and rape and torture and rob and this is the time for an organized counter attack.
- D. Arrogance will make anyone stupid and neutralize any ability anyone has inherent or acquired.
 - 1. Removal of key people is always a part of the strategy of clandestine warfare.
- E. If God does not promote you then you are not promoted and if God promotes you and does not demote you you then are not demoted and the plan will fail not because the plan is not good but because Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History.
 - 1. God and his plan is greater than any plan of any one in power any area or time in history.
 - 2. Furthermore when the means of accomplishing an objective is criminal violence and when it involves assassination of one in *legitimate* authority in the client nation and when it deprives the *rightful* of freedom and ignores establishment of authority it will fail.
 - 3. Thus it rejects the plan of God and Laws of Divine Establishment as well.
- F. The plans of criminal arrogance are compatible with the status quo of the planner.
 - 1. A plan may be brilliant but you must remember that Humility produces thinking while arrogance produces emotion
 - i. Arrogance as a complex and sin gives ascendancy to emotion in the soul.
 - ii. Humility gives ascendancy to thought in the soul.
 - iii. If emotion has ascendancy it cancels the ability of thought
 - iv. If thought has the ascendancy it gives emotion an honorable and wonderful function in life.
 - 2. Criminal activity never brings anything worth while to anyone.
 - i. Peace in the land as a result of criminal violence is a guarantee of tyranny and loss of human freedom.
 - ii. What is gained by criminality destroys freedom in the land.

- G. Clandestine warfare using Insurgency will be defeated by counter insurgency
 - 1. Insurgency is revolution
 - 2. Counter insurgency is counter revolution.
 - 3. The answer to the violence of revolution and the reign of terror is the application of grater violence by men of honor and integrity.
 - 4. This greater violence to defeat the violence of revolution will include both clandestine and conventional warfare.
 - 5. In clandestine warfare honorable men must shift gears into a ruthless strategy of counter insurgency so that men of evil genius are neutralized.
- H. For revolutionists a principle applies
 - 1. Those who live by revolutionary violence die be even greater violence and those who gain power by violence will be destroyed by the power of equal or greater violence.
 - 2. What counter insurgency does not destroy will be destroyed by conventional warfare on the battlefield.
- I. Deliverance in a civil war for establishment forces will be an imputation from the Justice of God to the Righteousness of God in the believers.
- XVII. Counter Insurgency problems and implications, Edgar S Furnace Jr.
 - A. Insurgency == Revolution Evil
 - B. Counter Insurgency == Anti Revolution Honorable
 - 1. All types of insurgency are different in origin, development and orientation and cover a wide area of activity.
 - 2. WE failed miserably in the area between clandestine and conventional warfare that being counter insurgency.
 - 3. We decide to pull out from various military actions in various ways without first examining what that pull out will result in over the long period of time.
 - 4. Maxwell Taylor used Vietnam as a laboratory for how to conduct counter insurgency and we failed miserably.
 - C. When the revolution becomes involved in the reign of terror which inevitably results from the overthrow of the principles of establishment they are thus incapable of thinking.
 - 1. Arrogance is the environment of mediocrity and the passive debilitation of thought.
 - D. Thought and decision requires humility, objectivity, flexibility combined with maximum Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul.
 - 1. It is never that the revolutionary staff lacks talent ability intelligence or mentality but their potential wisdom is neutralized by the Interlocking System of Arrogance and strong delusion.
 - E. Knowledge is the environment for thinking
 - 1. Metabolized Bible Doctrine is needed for any thinking by believers involved in counter insurgency.
 - 2. Unbelievers must function based on truth of Laws of Divine Establishment.
 - 3. Interlocking System of Arrogance can destroy either type.
 - F. You can only have thoughts which you personally understand and thus you must have in the Right Lobe of the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul the vocabulary and category of Bible Doctrine or Laws of Divine Establishment truth for planning and decisions.
 - G. Just as knowledge is the environment for thinking, Absolute Truth of Doctrine or Laws of Divine Establishment is the environment for decisions
 - 1. In a revolutionary counsel which is bound to the overthrow of the Laws of Divine Establishment and most likely rejects Bible Doctrine there are no effective decisions.
 - H. If you make choices on the basis of Bible Doctrine or Laws of Divine Establishment truth you continue to possess the freedom to make more and more choices.
 - 1. If you make decisions on the basis of arrogance in the environment of ignorance you limit your choices and reject good plans and eventually come to disaster.
 - 2. This can destroy a business by bad decisions changes in policies reactions to feet of clay,

etc.

- 3. Decisions based on arrogance of ignorance result in running out of choices so that nothing is left but Divine Discipline and Sin Unto Death
- I. Those involved in the use of conspiracy, violence, and revolution eventually run out of decisions
 - 1. They have first destroyed their own freedom of choice
 - 2. Then they have destroyed themselves from their own free will.
- J. When your choices are based in arrogance of the Interlocking System of Arrogance the person soon runs out of choices
 - 1. Drinking too much; Eating too much; Working too much; Etc.
 - 2. People like this never take responsibility for their own choices.
- K. For those who abandon honor and reject Bible Doctrine the future is dim and foreboding.
- L. When revolutionists run out of thoughts or plans by which they can win they must resort to violence where they will become greater losers and suffer horribly before they die.
- M. Problems and pressures in life:
 - 1. We make our own problems with our very own volition without help from anyone and don't have to be tempted.
 - 2. We are so stupid we don't have to be lured by temptation.
 - 3. We inevitably wind up where there are no decisions left.
 - 4. We lack totally in maturity and poise when we don't take responsibility for our own decisions.
 - 5. The thing which intensifies suffering is to fail to take responsibility for our own decisions.
 - 6. The only way to take responsibility for our decisions is to confess them to the Lord in rebound.
 - 7. Those who make from their own volition their problems and misery always resent the integrity of someone else.
 - 8. They are in Interlocking System of Arrogance
 - 9. There is no way, person or circumstance which can make the unhappy one happy since this is a state of soul in the Interlocking System of Arrogance.
 - 10. They have chosen to enter thus they are unhappy by choice.

N. Principle:

- 1. The function of counter insurgency is taking a plan which will not work and selling it to the revolutionary staff
 - i. This is bureaucracy.
- 2. Insurgency == Revolution while Counter insurgency == anti revolution.
 - i. Insurgency is anti God while counter insurgency is serving God.
 - ii. With men of equal ability the man with humility will defeat the arrogant one.
 - iii. Humility thinks under pressure while arrogance emotes under pressure.
- 3. Courage is thought under pressure while arrogance is emotion under pressure while Cowardice is emotion under pressure
- 4. Cowardly people can often do such a great job of fighting because when cornered they emote and go against all odds.
 - i. The reaction of the coward to pressure intensifies the emotion in his soul and he then does impulsive heroic things.
- 5. Merit in combat and the highest decorations must be given to those who think under pressure and those who do impulsive things should be subject to court martial.
- 6. The coward always functions from stupidity and under strong emotion.

XVIII. Thinking vs Emotion:

- A. It is ludicrous for people to make hero's out of emotionally unstable people.
 - 1. One emotional fling by many people results in decoration and medals
 - 2. This person is one who will destroy discipline in any unit and should be shot.
- B. HERO'S MUST BE ABLE TO THINK UNDER PRESSURE.

- 1. Fear under certain conditions is natural and normal
- 2. Courage is the ability to think and concentrate under pressure.
- C. If you live by emotions you are classically the coward who falls apart under pressure.
 - 1. You will never be happy.
 - 2. Courage and Heroism is not a matter of personality or effervescence but of the ability to think.
- D. Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul is the environment for thinking.
 - 1. If you want to be a winner learn to think
 - 2. If you want to be a loser keep on functioning under emotion.
 - 3. HOWEVER thinking requires vocabulary, categorical analysis and objectivity.
- E. The older you get the smarter you should get with intake of Bible Doctrine
 - 1. The smarter you get the more you can think and even if the body wears out and the brain does not you will be a greater asset than at any other time in life.
 - 2. If you use your brain instead of emotion and think instead of relying on brawn (for emergency only) you will get better all the time.
 - 3. If you try to push your way through with brawn only you will end up a total failure and a coward.
 - 4. You must work on thinking for it to become easy
 - 5. Bible Doctrine is designed to make you grow spiritually but also it is designed to give you God's perspective of life and allow you to LIVE.
 - 6. We must be able to use the Bible Doctrine we have learned by thinking and must be able to use the Faith Rest Drill (4 categories) to develop happiness, blessing, capacity and COURAGE.
 - 7. With the use of our volition, the more we choose for Bible Doctrine the greater the choices you have in life.
 - 8. The less you choose for doctrine you will run out of choices eventually.
 - 9. When you run out of choices for the function of your free will the only thing which is left is Divine Discipline
 - 10. This we then blame others for our problems rather than take responsibility and rebound and then start making good decisions beginning with rebound and then doctrine and more doctrine.
- F. The greatest disguise for a lie is TRUTH.
 - 1. If in telling a lie you can put in any truth and someone recognizes the truth if they are dumb enough they will think the whole thing is the truth.
 - 2. By not directly opposing a plan but introducing the time element doubts can be raised about the plan without bringing suspicion on self.
- G. When you take a lie and dress it up with truth you have deception.
 - 1. People see the truth distorted and never penetrate beyond the truth to the lie.
- H. Principle:
 - 1. Arrogance has no discernment and it become vulnerable to following weakness instead of strength.
 - 2. Arrogance replaces thought with prejudice.
 - 3. Prejudice produces incompetence and inefficiency.
 - 4. Counter insurgents must stimulate arrogance inculcate prejudice and create chaos and confusion in the revolutionary hierarchy.
 - 5. Espionage results in sabotage.

XIX. Principle

- A. Nothing appeals to arrogance as much as the innuendo that someone else is arrogant
 - 1. the effectiveness of counterinsurgency is seen when it arouses suspicion against leadership of any organization and appeals to the vanity of leaders without ability or competence in a field of function.

- i. You cannot ever negate great leadership.
- B. Counter insurgency undermines the best leadership and by appealing to arrogance guarantees the appointment of incompetent leadership.
 - 1. Many arrogant people possess a feminine quality that smothers and enslaves everyone in their periphery.
 - i. It is difficult for anyone of genius category to function under the control of someone susceptible to jealousy.
- *C. Arrogance cannot assign pure motivation to others.*
 - 1. If you are in an organization you MUST trust others to a point.
 - i. We all have Old Sin Natures but many have honor and integrity and are trustworthy.
 - 2. Any time a leader is arrogant he will get rid of the competent people under him.
 - i. A leader is no better than the competence of his subordinates
 - 3. If you are arrogant and suspicious of your subordinates and drive them away or into a shell of incompetence you destroy your own organization.
- D. Those in the Interlocking System of Arrogance are weak and vulnerable to flattery and extend themselves beyond their ability.
 - 1. The thing which will ruin you in a hurry is to extend yourself beyond your ability.
 - i. You can increase your ability with humility and diligence
 - ii. Humility increases ability while arrogance destroys ability.
 - 2. When in the Interlocking System of Arrogance a person loses his discernment.
 - i. All people in arrogance have a blind side no matter how great they are otherwise.
 - a. Business, profession and the spiritual life.
 - ii. Anyone in the Interlocking System of Arrogance no matter how great, successful, or smart have a blind side and it can be exploited to the disaster of the person in the Interlocking System of Arrogance
- E. The implication that victory goes to the largest army is ridiculous to anyone who is a student of strategy, tactics and military history.
 - 1. Arrogance is vulnerable to manipulation as well as flatter.
 - i. What starts with flattery ends up in manipulation.
 - ii. This is why we often have feminine rule in some form in society because men become so arrogant that the woman can manipulate him into many things.
 - 2. Enemy leadership must be manipulated by flattery combined with exploitation of jealousy, pettiness and vindictiveness.
 - i. It is impossible for petty vindictive people to be successful in command.
- F. Arrogance destroys ability, mentality and talent for greatness.
 - 1. You can be great OR Arrogant but these are mutually exclusive.
 - i. Arrogance flaws the person who attains greatness and this flawed person is vulnerable and weak and will be destroyed or destroy himself.
 - 2. Involvement in the Interlocking System of Arrogance is always a downfall.
 - i. This applies to all of us.
 - ii. No one can survive the involvement with Interlocking System of Arrogance
- G. Once you take a person with a flawed character who looks good and put him under pressure where he must make a decision which requires moral courage he is finished due to arrogance.
 - 1. All arrogant people are cowards
 - i. When under pressure that is when you see the coward exposed.
 - ii. An arrogant person may be physically strong and in a fight he may be courageous but when faced with greater threat or ability they show cowardice.
 - 2. Moral courage is the greatest asset in life in the concept of capacity for life and love.
 - i. No one can truly love anyone else unless they have moral courage.
 - 3. Moral courage is one of the greatest virtues in life and it is as great a virtue as arrogance is a destructive force.

- i. Arrogance flaws character and destroys capacity for life, love and happiness and ability to command and any form of success or greatness
- 4. Arrogance is the greatest enemy of the angelic and human realm.
 - i. Arrogance was so strong in Adam and Ishah that they rejected perfect environment.
 - ii. Satan appealed to the arrogance of Ishah to possibly be as smart as God.
 - iii. Then Adam in arrogance chose the woman outside the garden rather than God.
- 5. Arrogance is more powerful than perfect environment.
 - i. Arrogance is so powerful that it causes to make wrong choices when faced with good options.
 - ii. Environmentalism is the quintessence of human arrogance.
- H. Sooner or later someone will bring out the flaws of the arrogant person.
 - 1. Once you function under arrogance you will never make a good decision and every wrong decision you make destroys options for future decisions in any area of life.
 - 2. The mission of the counter insurgent is to discredit and neutralize any genius in leadership in the enemy
 - 3. Through counter insurgency with lies, deceit, flattery and innuendos to arouse suspicion, unlimited difficulties and dangers to sponsor fear and indecisiveness that mission can be accomplished.
- I. You cannot win wars without logistics
 - 1. You must be able to resupply personnel and equipment quickly
 - i. NO Military is better than its logistics.
 - 2. Because logistics in the United States of America depend on the president and congress and because we do not have personnel we are in the worst shape ever in 1980.
 - 3. The larger the army the greater the logistical problems also of command and organization along with strategy and tactics.
- J. In war you can only find the enemy if you never lose track of him.
 - 1. There should always be recon patrols out watching where he is going and how he is moving.
 - 2. The one who chooses the battlefield is usually the one who wins.
 - 3. You must have military intelligence and at the same time Reconnaissance so that both conventional and clandestine warfare must work together.
 - 4. You must know where the enemy is and and what they are doing else the enemy can keep you marching and moving until your incompetence destroys itself
 - 5. When people start to throw away equipment then you attack.
- K. If you are arrogant you have flawed character and are incompetent in any field of life.
 - 1. Arrogance guarantees that when the pressure comes you will crack open and be destroyed.
- L. All revolutionaries once they win something they like to stop and pillage and rape, rob and kill and torture.
 - 1. They are vulnerable to destruction because of lack of organization and discipline.
- M. When someone does something well it always looks easy and arrogance sees someone doing something and they make it look easy and thus the arrogant think they can do it.
 - 1. Arrogance assumes that everything is easy and counter insurgents must play on the arrogance of insurgent leaders.
 - 2. To an arrogant person if someone makes it sound easy then it looks easy if it sounds so easy then the Arrogant will buy it and fall into the trap of the deceit.
 - 3. Anything which is truly easy is not worth having.
 - 4. Lack of experience and arrogance is guaranteed disaster for any revolution.
- N. Reality is that the larger the force the greater the confusion during a night attack
 - 1. Night attack requires years of training for officers and incredible training over long periods of time.

- 2. Victory in thinking precedes victory in battle.
 - i. Someone must think and someone must response and must have capabilities for response.
- O. Knowledge is the environment and humility is the servant of that knowledge.
 - 1. Arrogant leaders can only fall back on emotion and cowardice is emotion and visualize the victory over there enemies but can never carry it out.
 - 2. You can only have thoughts which you personally understand and when a leader does not have the technical knowledge nor the ability to think and function under pressure he can be defeated.
- XX. Sun Zu is studied by all communist regimes and used extensively by their military leaders.
 - A. The Art or war is governed by 5 constant factors to be taken into account in one's deliberations when seeking to determine the conditions obtained in the field.
 - 1. Moral Law
 - i. Causes people to be in complete accord with their leader, they will follow the leader regardless of their lives undismayed by any dagner
 - 2. Heaven
 - i. Night, Day, Cold, Heat, Time and Seasons.
 - ii. All Factors for military decisions.
 - 3. Earth
 - i. Distances great and small, dangers and security on open ground and narrow passages, chances of life and death.
 - 4. Commander
 - i. Standing for the virtues of wisdom, benevolence, courage and mostly strictness
 - 5. Method and Discipline:
 - i. Marshaling of the army in its subdivisions, grading of rank in officers, the maintenance of roads for logistics, control of military expenditures.
 - B. When seeking to determine the military decisions make them by comparing
 - 1. Which of the 2 sovereigns is imbued with the moral law
 - 2. Which of the 2 generals have the greater ability
 - 3. With whom lies the advantages derived from heaven and earth
 - 4. With which side is discipline most rigorously enforced.
 - 5. Which army is the stronger not largest.
 - 6. Which officers and men are most highly trained
 - 7. In which army is there the greatest constancy both in reward and punishment
 - i. Without these an army cannot be consistent.
 - ii. The army which is out of control and allowed by their leaders to pillage and rape and destroy things this army is defeated.
 - iii. These 7 forecast both victory and defeat
 - C. All warfare is based on deception
 - 1. When able to attack seem unable
 - 2. When using forces appear inactive
 - 3. When near make the enemy think you are far away.
 - 4. When far away make the enemy think you are near.
 - 5. Hold out baits to entice the enemy
 - 6. Feign disorder and then crush him.
 - 7. If he is secure at all points be prepared for him.
 - 8. If he is superior in strength evade him.
 - 9. If the opponent has an unstable temper seek to irritate him.
 - 10. Pretend weakness so he may grow arrogant since the arrogant always lose.
 - 11. If he is taking his ease give him no rest.
 - 12. If his forces are united separate them.
 - 13. Attack him where he is unprepared

- 14. Appear where not expected.
- XXI. Victory in thinking precedes victory in battle]
 - A. Thinking is the greatest virtue and least understood or appreciated by most.
 - B. The road to freedom is constructed by military victory
 - C. Once the road is constructed and freedom obtained then the road to freedom must be maintained by the Laws of Divine Establishment
 - 1. These provide freedom in the economic realm and *governmental must protect free enterprise from the criminal and crusader alike.*
 - i. The crusader is just as evil as the criminal.
 - 2. Capitalism is the only economic system in life and socialism is not an economic system but an evil ideology designed to destroy freedom thus a major issue in the Angelic Conflict
 - 3. Socialism and the welfare state cannot exist without support from capitalism.
 - 4. Free enterprise when it functions right results in freedom and pursuit of happiness to the extent that an individual can.

XXII. The divine application of clandestine warfare:

- A. Victory in clandestine warfare results in victory in conventional warfare
 - 1. Often the battle is won long before the battlefield is determined because of success in clandestine war.
- B. Victory in thinking precedes victory in fighting.
 - 1. This applies to thinking in clandestine war and counter insurgency as well as staff function in conventional war.
- C. Knowledge is the environment for thinking
 - 1. Both those in secret service and in general staff must have professional knowledge for thinking.
 - 2. Without professional thinking there is mediocrity in function and this person does not keep up with advances in their field.
 - 3. In a situation where two people of equal mentality are fighting it out the humble one always wins and the arrogant always loses.
 - i. Arrogance is a handicap in conflict and in life in general.
- D. Thinking requires humility, which is objectivity and flexibility used to result in victory.
 - 1. A standard scale of values for clandestine war requires avoidance of conventional scale of values which focus on morality and spirituality.
- E. God not only approves the Modus Operandi of clandestine war but sponsors client nation counter insurgency, however NOT in a police state but in a client nation.
 - 1. No client nation can maintain its client nation status and be a police state or a system of tyranny.
 - 2. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ thus approves and sponsors client nation counter insurgency.
 - 3. He does not approve any counter insurgency nor clandestine war function of any police state such as any of the communist nations.
- F. The morality or immorality of any nation determines the legitimacy of its secret services.
 - 1. Moral nations have legitimate secret services while the secret services of immoral nations such as Russia or China are illegitimate thus EVIL.
 - 2. In england MI5 and MI6 and in the United States of America the CIA and NSA are legitimate.
 - 3. The Lord also approves counter insurgency function in police work as well and the larger the city the larger the CID should be.
- G. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History and this is the overriding principle
 - 1. The Best plans of any one can be frustrated and may be frustrated by DIRTY work of counter insurgency when the Lord is behind it as in a client nation function against revolution and civil war

- i. Lying, deception, exploitation of weakness, murder, sabotage, etc. are all acceptable methods to victory.
- H. In frustrating the better plan of any genius tyrant or military enemy God can only use a mature believer a man with great honor, integrity, great morality and spirituality and one whose reputation was beyond reproach.
 - 1. The methods used to frustrate the 'better' plan can be Lying, Deceit, Exploitation, Using the weakness of others, creating illusion in the mind of some and delusion in the mind of others.
 - 2. When in conflict you have approximately equal genius on both sides it is the humility factor which wins.
 - i. Humility is flexible and flexibility defeats inflexibility.
 - ii. Humility is object and objectivity defeats subjectivity.
 - iii. He must be a man of morality and spirituality and a great believer and able to think.
 - iv. He must have Bible Doctrine and Rationales for the situation.
 - v. He must be able to shift into a scale of values for clandestine war
 - vi. He must be able to lie and make it sound like the truth
 - vii. He must be able to set up fabrication which will deceive
 - viii. He must be able to estimate cowardice and weakness in the Interlocking System of Arrogance and thus exploit weakness to defeat the enemy.
- I. God never approves of revolution or those involved in it nor of conspiracy and those involved in it.
 - 1. God uses the arrogance of revolution and of revolutionary leaders to destroy the leaders and the revolution
 - i. Arrogance destroys itself
 - ii. Whatever comes to arrogance by way of disaster arrogance always destroys itself.
 - iii. A person who is arrogant and is destroyed by arrogance can only blame himself but rarely does.
- J. Those who live and then die by evil
 - 1. This describes what happens to revolution and any form of conspiracy and any function where Interlocking System of Arrogance is the motivation.
 - i. It shows that the system of arrogance adopted by one inevitably results in evil and this arrogance and evil destroys the person who choses them.
 - 2. The Justice of God administers punishment in the environment of the evil created by the evil men in arrogance.
 - 3. So the evil men create the means of destroying themselves thus create their own destruction.
 - i. Arrogance destroys arrogance and Evil destroys evil.
 - ii. It is self destructive to become involved in arrogance and thus evil.
 - iii. Revolution is motivated by arrogance and results in evil.
 - iv. Crusader Arrogance + Criminal Arrogance == Revolution.
- K. No one becomes involved in Revolution or conspiracy or seeks revenge or destruction of another except by personal volition involvement
 - 1. Motivation of this volitional function is the Interlocking System of Arrogance
 - 2. Volition makes choices for evil and arrogance until these build up and cause volition to run out of choices.
 - 3. Those who create disaster for others inevitably bring disaster on themselves.
 - 4. This Principle is true of other factors as well,
 - For the individual it is true of Gossip, Maligning, Judging, Revenge Modus Vivendi and Modus Operandi
 - ii. It is true of conspiracy and revolution and it is true that Revolution eats her own children.

- L. Victory in thinking precedes victory in battle and in business.
 - 1. Victory in clandestine war precedes victory in conventional war.
 - 2. Clandestine war has a set of standards needed for success
 - 3. Conventional war has a set of standards needed for success and each is different.
 - 4. The standards of clandestine war are not the same as the standards of conventional war but there are some overlap.
 - 5. The standards of conventional war relate to honor and integrity and morality in killing the enemy and defeating him while those for clandestine war are those normally classified as sin and immorality.
 - 6. However, In the context of clandestine war and counter insurgency function these standards must be reclassified as necessary, patriotic, honorable, and not in conflict with either integrity nor the spiritual life of the believer.
 - Lying and deception and other functions in this status are not sins and thus justified.
- M. Killing the enemy in war is not the sin of murder and both conventional and clandestine war have this common standard.
 - 1. In conventional war it is the responsibility of the unit commander to maintain discipline both on and off the battlefield in both rear echelon and front line contact with the enemy.
 - i. He determines the time at which the enemy is to be killed and in obedience to those orders the believer who is under Filling of God the Holy Spirit function with his weapons and is the best killer of the outfit
 - ii. He has not committed murder and has no spiritual conflict at all.
 - 2. It is the soldiers job under command to kill the enemy in war however the standard of discipline demands that soldiers do not commit acts of crime or sin against civilians.
 - i. This is seen in Lee's invasion of the north vs Sherman's invasion of the south.
 - ii. Old Sin Natures must be controlled in the military with strict discipline and as with criminals if there are violations they must be killed in equally horrible ways to their crimes.
 - 3. In clandestine warfare you are to intimidate the civilian or military alike and kill, assassinate, lie, steal, cheat, everything and anything to gain intelligence and neutralize the effectiveness enemy.
 - 4. Soldiers are punished for rape, pillage, stealing murder etc of civilians thus conventional war demands that the client nation army observe a strict code of morality toward the civilian population where battle is being fought.
 - 5. The *antithesis* is true with regard to clandestine warfare.

XXIII.Sun Zu Continued:

- A. Attack by strategy
 - 1. Take the enemies whole nation intact
 - 2. To shatter the country and destroy it is not good
 - 3. To capture an enemy regiment, detachment or company in its entirety is better than to destroy it.
- B. To fight and conquer in all your battles is not supreme excellence.
 - 1. Supreme excellence is in breaking the enemies resistance without fighting.
 - 2. Balk the enemies plans
 - 3. Prevent the junction of the enemies forces
 - 4. Attack the army in the field
 - 5. Worst policy is to besiege walled cities which is very time and personnel consuming.
- C. Skilled leader
 - 1. Subdues troops without fighting
 - 2. Captures cities without laying siege to them.
 - 3. Overthrows kingdoms without any lengthy operations in the field
 - 4. Forces intact he will dispute the mastery of the empire and without losing a man his

triumph will be complete

- D. It is the rule in war if our forces are
 - 1. 10 to 1 Surround him
 - 2. 5 to 1 Attack him
 - 3. 2 to 1 Divide our army into 2
 - 4. 1 to 1 Offer Battle
 - 5. If slightly inferior in number Avoid the enemy
 - 6. If totally unequal in every way flee from him.
 - 7. <u>An obstinate fight may be made by a small force but in the end it must be captured or destroyed by the larger force.</u>
- E. 5 Essentials for victory
 - 1. He will win who knows when to fight and when not to fight.
 - 2. Who knows how to handle both superior and inferior forces
 - 3. Whose army is animated with the same spirit throughout all the ranks
 - 4. Who prepares himself and waits to take the enemy unprepared.
 - 5. Who has military capacity and is not interfered with by his sovereign. (Government)
- F. Numerical weakness comes form having to prepare for possible attacks and strength comes from compelling your adversary to make these preparations against you.
 - 1. Military tactics like water runs away from high places
 - 2. In war the way to avoid what is strong strike what is weak.
 - 3. Water shapes his course according to the ground over which it flows
 - 4. The soldier works out his victory according to the foe which he is facing
 - 5. Water retains no constant shape so in war there are no constant contradictions.
 - 6. FLEXIBILITY is the key
- G. Maneuvering with an army is advantageous but with an undisciplined multitude most dangerous.
 - 1. An army of stags led by a lion is to be feared more than an army of lions led by a stag.
- H. A soldiers spirit is keenest in the morning by noon it has begun to ebb in the evening his mind is bent only on returning to camp.
 - 1. A keen general avoids an army when its spirit is keen and attacks it when its spirit is sluggish and inclined to return to camp.,
 - 2. This is studying moods and a general must know moods as well as strategy.
- I. 5 dangerous faults which may effect a general.
 - 1. Recklessness which leads to destruction.
 - 2. Cowardice which leads to capture
 - 3. A hasty temper which can be provoked by insults
 - 4. A delicacy of honor sensitive to shame.
 - 5. Being over solicitous for his men exposing him to worry and trouble.

XXIV. Principles:

- A. Conventional war demands a strict code of morality toward a civilian population in a war zone
- B. This is a part of discipline just a fire control against the enemy is in conventional war
 - 1. Strict morality toward a civilian population cannot ever be overlooked by a commander.
- C. In clandestine war a different standard is absolutely needed one in which lying, deceit, torture, intimidation, assassination etc are proven standards for fighting the enemy.
 - 1. Activities which are normally sinful functions in counter insurgency must be classified as honorable and patriotic with no loss of spirituality.
 - 2. This is not sinning in counter insurgency functions and there was no loss of fellowship with the Lord.
 - 3. Divine approval of counter insurgency is confirmed in **2Sam 17:14b**.
 - 4. God is perfect and cannot sin and cannot solicit to sin and cannot approve of sin as a means to anything.
 - 5. God approves using lying and deceit to frustrate the plan of enemies and bring them to disaster or destruction.

6. God cannot not and does not use sin as a means to an end thus since as seen **in 2Sam** he used counter insurgency it is concluded that counter insurgency is a legitimate and patriotic function of a client nation against its enemies

XXV. Victory in Clandestine Warfare

- A. Arrogant people are unstable and could switch back to the original destructive plans at any time after being deceived.
- B. The means of the information transfer and intelligence function often use women
 - 1. God uses women who know doctrine just as he uses the man who knows doctrine but in different ways.
 - 2. This often is the courage of the woman where the difference between life and death and success and failure in clandestine warfare.
 - 3. A woman must have great humility and doctrine and incredible flexibility to think under pressure.

C. Principle:

- 1. Strategically and Tactically there is no substitute for interior lines.
 - i. This allows a unit operating on interior lines to switch direction no matter which direction the enemy comes from.
- 2. This should force the enemy to take the initiative and extend his supply lines and make mistakes.
 - i. When He must pursue with a large army and extend his supply lines this creates logistical problems which are more difficult to solve and potentially cause many mistakes.
 - ii. This is in addition to sloppy poorly disciplined army personnel will aid victory for the establishment.
- 3. Arrogance is characterized by indecisiveness and instablity
 - i. Instability produces Indecisiveness
- 4. Before an effective campaign can be mounted against another army there must be separation of civilians from the army for effective maneuver before battle.
- 5. To the extent that civilians are intermixed with military to that extent there is inefficiency in the time of campaigning
 - i. They are not trained and must not be involved.
 - ii. To the extent that the army becomes entangled with civilians to that extent it cannot function properly even if well trained.
- 6. There must be an established HQ to give soldiers a place to concentrate for mobilization, reorganization an concentration of force
 - i. There must be an effective table of organization and order of battle
- 7. Motivation can defeat superior ability every time.
 - i. Talent + Arrogance destroys talent
 - ii. Thoughtfulness + Humility offsets any handicap a person may have.
- 8. Humility is an essential part of Honorable service and function in life

D. Clandestine Warfare must be clandestine and everyone involved must blend into the background

- 1. Blend in naturally as in usual functions
 - i. Or Hide out
 - ii. Or appear to be doing what they normally do
 - iii. Or appear to be friend when actually an enemy
 - iv. You must either phase out or blend in.
- 2. There must be team work in any type of clandestine war, intelligence and counter intelligence and counter insurgency.
 - i. This is the same as in conventional warfare
 - ii. Teamwork demands honorable motivation, patriotic integrity and humility of thought and function.

- 3. Effective and competent Modus Operandi in clandestine war depends on many people all doing their job well.
 - i. The principle of discipline and team work applies like in conventional war and is the key to victory.
 - ii. Clandestine war does not remove the principles of honor and integrity and discipline
 - iii. There must be great courage, great thinkers, great command, leaders, followers, support systems in both conventional and clandestine war.
 - iv. This must be so in Intelligence, counter intelligence, counter insurgency, espionage, sabotage, attack, barrage
 - v. It is the same in all aspects of war in that that the failure of one branch means death of those in the other branches.
- 4. You must never divorce from teamwork these concepts and remember that teamwork is caused by:
 - i. Honor
 - ii. Integrity
 - iii. Self Discipline
 - iv. Motivation from establishment patriotism and/or Bible Doctrine
- 5. Without intelligence officers, couriers, transfer persons, analyzers, etc defeat in clandestine war could result in defeat in conventional war.
 - i. Genius in war leadership is no better than the information on which to make a decision.
 - ii. Genius in leadership is no better than the execution by the man in the ranks.
 - iii. Without this intelligence information the generals in command and their staff are handicapped and vulnerable to defeat.
- 6. Each member of the team contributes to victory in clandestine war.
 - i. No 2 agents are equal each with their own ability and contribution each has a job great or small each contribution is signification and requires humility, objectivity flexibility so that jealousy, arrogance and bitterness does not hinder the Modus Operandi of the secret service.
 - ii. Arrogance subjectivity and inflexibility often result in bitterness and self pity because of lack of recognition of honorable service
 - iii. Arrogance means vulnerability to succumbing to temptations of becoming a double agent.
- 7. 2 categories are automatically eliminated from clandestine war.
 - i. Arrogant People
 - ii. Stupid People
 - a. One stupid or arrogant person disobeying orders can destroy the greatest plan devised.
 - iii. Discipline is enforced humility is used to overcome arrogance and stupidity
 - a. Humility must always win the day.

XXVI. Success of a Mission of Counter insurgency

- A. This success requires courage on the part of all of the parties involved in acquiring and delivering intelligence information
- B. Conventional warfare commanders must have information with which to make decisions
 - 1. Never make a decision without proper information:
 - 2. Sometimes this is Bible Doctrine broken into its logical rationales.
 - 3. Sometimes it is accurate information given by those responsible for gathering and delivering it in warfare.
- C. Thus there is emphasis on intelligence in conventional warfare
 - 1. Conventional warfare depends on clandestine warfare both to confuse the enemy and also gain accurate information regarding enemy forces, terrain, order of battle etc.

- 2. Always remember that night operations take incredible organization to accomplish successfully.
 - i. This type of operation requires great efficiency and order and great humility often in the form of enforced humility.
- 3. Discipline is enforced humility in one form or another.
 - i. Success of this type of night operation requires humility both real and enforced.
 - ii. When successful it shows great command structure and discipline and establishment orientation.
- D. Knowledge is the environment for thinking
 - 1. Command decisions must be based on Intelligence information
- E. Thinking is the environment for decisions
 - 1. Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul plus the Intelligence provided by clandestine operations combines to bring a commander to the point of decision.
 - 2. Good decisions in war will becomes the basis for making many more decisions.
 - i. Thus commanders will be able to make every possible type of decision, strategic, tactical, protective, etc.
 - 3. If you make a bad decision you will cancel future options for decisions
 - i. If you continue to make bad decisions you will cancel all options for more decisions until you only have the Sin Unto Death left to you.
 - 4. Good decisions multiply future options while bad decisions limit future options and eventually the one who makes more and more bad decisions runs out of options all together.
- F. Just as knowledge is the environment for thinking Bible Doctrine is the environment for making decisions.
 - 1. You must only consult your own soul where Metabolized Bible Doctrine resides for your own decisions.
 - 2. If you have Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and you consult your soul for your decisions they will be good decisions
 - 3. If you make decisions based on Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and what you know such as having 2 scale of values for life.
 - 4. With abnormal circumstances decisions will be quite different in natural or national disasters of weather, war, riots, revolution.
 - 5. IF you operate on only one scale of values which function well for normal circumstances in life then you will end up in horrible misery and finally go to heaven.
 - 6. We must have 2 scale of values and be able to walk out on everything which we ever considered important in life leaving it to looters and destruction.
 - i. We must be able to abandon the normal scale of values and accept and function under the abnormal scale of values
 - 7. Every believer is supposed to be spiritually self sustaining and the only way for this to occur is for each believer to be able to think under pressure
- G. Cowardice, Fear, Panic is negative emotion
 - 1. If negative emotion dominates the soul then you cannot think.
 - i. Thinking must be used to blow out emotion from our Stream of Consciousness of the Soul in order to survive any disaster of any kind.
 - 2. Thinking must include the doctrinal rationales
 - i. Plan of God
 - ii. Essence of God
 - iii. Logistical Grace
 - iv. Judicial Imputations
 - v. Rebound
 - vi. Afortori

- vii. Etc.
- 3. These bring spiritual growth and also are to be used to apply to experiences for survival in the Cosmic Dynasphere
 - If you make bad decisions in the time of crisis you will die.

XXVII. Principles:

- A. In choosing a secure area to develop a battlefield or sanctuary, try to choose an elevated area (not a mountainous one) where you can see your enemy coming and evaluate the situation.
- B. A mountainous area prevents you from maintaining logistical support and you are in essence easily trapped.
- C. The army with the best discipline generally wins because discipline produces humility
 - 1. Poor discipline == arrogance and arrogance on the battlefield usually results in defeat on the battlefield.
 - 2. It is difficult for an army to move through an area with hostile citizenry which will make logistical support very very difficult for them.
- D. Arrogant men always feel like there is safety in numbers which is a false premise.
 - 1. Safety is found ONLY in the Wall of Fire even without any numbers and "if God for us, Who against us"?
 - 2. Absalom had in fact adopted the plan of Hushai which was designed and guaranteed to fail.
 - 3. To the extent you are involved in Interlocking System of Arrogance to that extent you are weak.
 - 4. The longer you spend in Interlocking System of Arrogance and the more of the categories of arrogance interact in your life the Weaker you become.
 - 5. This neutralizes whatever talent or ability or greatness you might have had.
 - 6. Volition makes decisions in this situation and then you run out of options.

XXVIII. Summary of Principles of Counter Insurgency

- A. Principle 1
 - 1. Counter Insurgency is the destruction of enemy leadership, thinking, talent, and planning.
 - 2. Every believer must have 2 scales of value one for prosperity and one for adversity.
 - 3. The transition from prosperity scale of values to the historical crisis scale of values demands the status quo of Humility
 - i. This includes Objectivity and Flexibility.
 - 4. The material things which the believer has enjoyed in prosperity must be instantly written off or abandoned or ignored in historical adversity.
 - i. This requires great flexibility.
 - 5. Once you enter adversity it is not what you have that counts it is what you think which counts.
 - i. The real secret to navigating pressure in life is to ignore everything you possess and everything you have attained and whatever rank or ability or success or however you are recognized in normal times since it no longer counts in abnormal times.
 - ii. You must abandon everything you have accumulated and everything you depend on for recognition and move to what you can do with what you have in your soul.
 - 6. The believer must recognize when adversity comes and must be able to switch his scale of values to weather the storm of crisis whether that storm is revolution, civil war, or conventional war with another nation.
 - 7. One must be humble, flexible, objective and honorable in the function of the Faith Rest Drill _(4 categories) in reverse concentration.
 - i. There are much more important things in life than decoration or promotion these being your personal integrity and honor.
 - ii. In time of pressure and disaster it is not the rank or success you have attained in peace time or how wealthy or prominent you have become it is what you have in

the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and your ability to apply truth in the form of Laws of Divine Establishment or Bible Doctrine through the Faith Rest Drill (4 categories).

- 8. Furthermore to shift into the adversity scale of values the believer must have maximum Metabolized Bible Doctrine in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and having it categorically stored so that it can be recovered and used in definitive rationales.
 - i. Plan of God, Essence of God, Afortori, Logistical Grace, Judicial Imputation, Rebound rationales.
 - ii. Our daily studies are designed to allow to learn Bible Doctrine and organize it into categories and thus in times of disaster we can identify the needed category and make instant application.
- 9. Without the Faith Rest Drill (4 categories) and reverse concentration the believer cannot apply rationales of Bible Doctrine nor adapt to his scale of values for adversity.
 - i. We sit and learn to concentrate when not motivated nor interested in the subject and learn poise and this basis for learning Bible Doctrine is the basis by which it is then able to be applied.
 - ii. This same concentration by which we learn Bible Doctrine is the same concentration which we must use in application.
 - iii. Our prayer life is indicative of our ability to concentrate.
 - iv. Effectiveness in prayer is based on concentration.
 - v. It is easy to concentrate on something you enjoy or that motivates you but Bible Doctrine has at times things which are of no interest to us but we must realize that these are still important and we must concentrate.
 - vi. Our ability to concentrate and the content of what we are learning under concentration is the very basis for survival in disaster.
 - vii. Our survival does not depend on what we have stored up as material but on what is in our Stream of Consciousness of the Soul and this takes THOUGHT.
 - viii. The concentration and scale of values that means survival for us in disaster is what gives us capacity for life, love and happiness in normal times.
- 10. Changing circumstances do not change blessing from the Justice of God.
 - i. Going from prosperity circumstances to adversity from normal to abnormal this does not change the Plan of God and not change the blessings of God from the Justice of God to the Righteousness of God in us and these will be compatible with the historical occasion.
 - ii. We must learn happiness and contentment and it does not depend on having our dreams fulfilled or finding the Right Man or Right Woman
 - iii. Happiness is in fact a state of mind.

B. Principle 2

- 1. Remember that while there are 2 scale of values one for prosperity and one for adversity and Bible Doctrine must be first in both.
 - i. Counter insurgency and Clandestine warfare in general demands that the person involved possesses both honor and integrity along with patriotism and understanding that this type of warfare requires lying, cheating, stealing, killing, and exploitation of all sorts of human weakness and vanity.
 - ii. These believers in counter insurgency must not lose their honor nor integrity nor their Bible Doctrine but at the same time must function under a new scale of values and one in which there is required more use of honor and integrity than in normal times.
- 2. While these things of counter insurgency function are considered sinful and evil in normal living they are a part and package of normal Modus Operandi in secret service function.
- 3. Normal conventional moral standards cannot be applied to clandestine war any more than

- normal conventional moral standards can be applied to normal conventional war.
- 4. To succeed in the nasty business of secret service one must combine honor and integrity with lying, deceit, fabrication, bribing and general exploitation of weakness of others.
 - i. Just as killing in battle is not murder when in war for your country lying and deceit and the rest is not sinful in counter intelligence or counter insurgency.
 - ii. This also applies to Law Enforcement officers in Criminal Intelligence functions.
- 5. Insurgency == Revolution and thus connotes EVIL thus Counter insurgency is identified with preservation of establishment government and freedom thus has an honorable connotation.

C. Principle 3

- 1. Since revolution believes the lie under strong delusion and arrogance of ignorance God judges revolution with their own weapons of lying and deceit and propaganda and counter violence.
- 2. Revolution lives by the lie and thus it is fitting that it be destroyed by the lie.
- 3. Revolution succeeds by use of violence thus it is fitting that it be destroyed by counter violence.
- 4. Revolution is the result of maximum arrogance and involvement in Interlocking System of Arrogance thus it is fitting that it be destroyed and defeated by that same arrogance complex which produces both weakness and spheres of vulnerability guaranteed to defeat the revolution.
- 5. Revolution in arrogance creates its own system of self destruction and thus God both authorizes and approves of counter insurgency functions as a means of destroying revolution. **2Sam 17:14**
 - i. Ps 76:10 God uses the wrath of man to praise him and the rest of mans wrath he God will restrain.
- 6. Part of the principle that Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History is the fact that God uses the wrath of man to praise him.
- 7. James 4:6, 1Pet 5;5 must be remembered, "God makes war against the arrogant but he gives grace to the Humble".
 - i. Counter insurgency is clandestine warfare against the arrogance of revolution and insurgency.
- D. National disaster never changes the Plan of God for the believer (X + Y + Z) continues in time of disaster as it does in time of prosperity.
 - 1. Often the material blessings of life must be abandoned or ignored but loss of material things does not imply loss of the source of the blessing from the Justice of God.
 - 2. A mole is an agent of one country whose objective is to infiltrate the highest echelon of enemy command to gain secret information and also to plant disinformation and to neutralize leadership genius and capability by intimidation, blackmail, flattery and violence.
 - 3. Being inside the Interlocking System of Arrogance guarantees weakness and vulnerability to counter insurgency as well as Conventional Warfare.
 - 4. Revolution often gains the initial advantage and success because of the arrogance of the general population plus their strong delusion from rejection of truth in 3 categories:
 - i. Laws of Divine Establishment
 - ii. Gospel of Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ
 - iii. Bible Doctrine for believers.
 - iv. This HAS occurred in our country and we are on the brink of disaster because of great national arrogance.
 - 5. The Lord's choice and the people's choice are never the same 1Sam 16:7
 - 6. Whatever the potential of the leaders of revolution and the potential of the architects of revolution their involvement in the Interlocking System of Arrogance destroys all of their ability and potential.

- 7. A Mole must infiltrate the highest echelon of revolutionary command through flattery and deception and ability to weave truth into lies forming a tapestry of Counter Insurgency.
- 8. Crusader Arrogance + Criminal Arrogance == Revolution:
 - i. As revolution progresses the ascendancy of criminal arrogance and violence results in civil war.
 - ii. The reign of terror shows the incompetency of the revolution to provide and semblance of establishment government.

E. Principle 4

- 1. The transfer of power and authority from establishment government to revolution inevitably results in violence or reign of terror
- 2. The reign of terror manifests criminal arrogance and also the irresponsibility of revolutionary leadership.
- 3. Revolution always involves those in for revenge and they use the coup De tat to take personal revenge against their enemies.
- 4. Revolutionary arrogance produces subjectivity of thinking and inflexibility of administration which results in great violence and injustice.
- 5. Knowledge is the environment for thinking and Bible Doctrine (or any form of absolute truth) is the environment for making good decisions.
- 6. The ignorance of arrogance includes ignorance of Bible Doctrine (or any form of absolute truth) and results in making bad decisions
- 7. If you make a good decision you increase your options for more and greater decisions plus increasing freedom to do so.
 - i. Bad decision limit options for future decisions and for life, love and pursuit of happiness and eventually you lose your freedom and destroy your choices and nothing is left but Divine Discipline.
- 8. Arrogance is stronger than perfect environment or any good environment from establishment government.
 - i. Arrogance in authority often becomes inflexible about the wrong things.
 - ii. You must be careful when making rules so that you do not become inflexible with them because you may limit the ability of a person to function under them.
- 9. People are not content with good administration or ability in business or good government as seen in our nation in the democratic party.
 - i. The Old Sin Nature does not want good government nor perfect environment since it originated from arrogance in rejection of the perfect environment of the garden and it will reject 1000 years of perfect environment of the reign of Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ.
- 10. Arrogance is more than a sin it is a major system of evil and the greatest power of evil in the world.
 - i. When people become arrogant good government is rejected and they accept idiotic presidents or leaders in any area.
- 11. Revolutionary arrogance rejects great freedom and prosperity from the Laws of Divine Establishment thus arrogance is stronger than perfect environment and also stronger than true love.
 - i. Revolutionary arrogance rejected the greatest prosperity and freedom in all of Jewish history the reign of David.
 - ii. Arrogance takes magnificent love and turns it into hatred and as a system of evil it is stronger than most of the systems of good (although God has provided some counter balance for this)

F. Principle 5:

1. The transfer of power through lawlessness and violence of revolution is a manifestation of man's inability to enjoy or appreciate freedom apart from the Laws of Divine Establishment with the strong system of authority which comes with it.

- i. This is why we must appreciate police and fire fighters and military personnel despite the arrogance of any person in charge.
- ii. People fail in all areas of life but we cannot get along without establishment thus we need police, fire, military, government functioning on a professional level.
- iii. As long as we have establishment government we must honor those who allow us to retain it.
- iv. When violence comes in, in the form of revolution and lawlessness we thus have lost everything.
- v. We still have freedom, to a limited extent, of speech, despite political correctness attempting to destroy even that.
- vi. God gave us the Laws of Divine Establishment to define the needed authority to maintain freedom and perpetuate the Angelic Conflict
- 2. Legitimate authority is necessary for legitimate freedom.
 - i. We have people put in power by the stupidity of the public but this is not the violence of revolution.
- 3. Revolution seeks to demote establishment rulers and ignores the fact that if God does not promote you then you are not promoted and if God does not demote you, you are not demoted.

XXIX. Conventional Warfare Functions:

- A. There is uncertainty in an army which is a brand new organization and have not fought together ever before and the officers do not know the men nor vice versa thus there will be concern regarding having to retreat.
- B. This is a mistaken concept but reasonable when they are unfamiliar with the officers and vice versa and have never worked before and have not stable situation.
- C. The majority can be wrong about the officer corps if the officers joined because of application of Metabolized Bible Doctrine to the situation.
- D. If the men and the officers have rejected the concept of revolution and the bureaucracy found in the military involved in it and have great honor and integrity form Metabolized Bible Doctrine they will prove great in their leadership under new conditions and become the backbone for a military organization which will excel.
- E. Even if the men do not know their officers and the officers don't know the men but the officers know their Bible Doctrine and will apply it under pressure and there will success for the organization.
- F. When an organization is broken up and the men find themselves with unaccustomed leadership they naturally have suspicion.
 - 1. This provides a great potential for arrogance.
 - 2. They must never try to superimpose their judgment over that of their officers.
- G. The officers in a new organization must develop a system of discipline and do it rapidly so that there will be enforced humility for the work ahead.
 - The lives of the men in ranks depend on enforced humility and being able to do their job under abnormal circumstances combat and of having new leadership and being a scratch army.
- H. This being a patchwork army where officers are assigned to units never commanded before the ranks won't have any confidence in the officers having never trained together and there will be suspicion and uncertainty.
 - 1. Suspicion always produces the possibility of arrogance.
 - 2. When people become suspicious of those in authority over them the next step is to find self in the Interlocking System of Arrogance
 - 3. The army must not focus thinking on retreating while they have not even advanced as yet.
- I. The officer corps which is developed must be great in their thinking, honor and integrity.
- J. You cannot think about self when in a group under pressure for if you think about self when in a group under pressure you cease to be a professional individual.

- 1. This applies to Military, Social, Business, Professional, any organization.
- 2. This will cause arrogance to destroy the talent of the team.
- 3. Your thinking must be in regard to the overall team function and the part you have trained to perform in that team.
- K. Knowledge is the environment for thinking and courage is the environment for correct decisions on the battlefield.
 - 1. Whether advancing or retreating, forming a column or a line.
 - 2. Courage is the ability to apply knowledge under any pressure of disaster.
 - 3. Knowledge of military science and Bible Doctrine gives those in command correct thinking.

L. Principle:

- 1. The 2 greatest problems any army will have is the needed enforced humility and logistics both of which must be overcome.
- 2. What officers lack in combat experience can be made up in honor, integrity, humility, objectivity, flexibility and leadership qualities which would produce the highest quality officer.
 - i. Combat experience is meaningless in the area of leadership.
 - ii. It is not experience which counts for leadership but honor, integrity, humility, objectivity, flexibility and leadership qualities.
 - iii. Experience does not mean a thing if it is not good experience.
- 3. Officer corps must be built on the above qualities not combat experience.
 - i. What will destroy the officers and the military of any nation is lack of thought in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul ie lack of integrity and honor and thus no courage.
 - ii. The greatest officer in World War II had no combat experience ever before but had the greatest honor and integrity.
- 4. It is not experience which counts but it is what goes on in the mind of the person.
 - i. This is the same thing which occurs when you are job seeking and they want experience.
 - ii. Those who have what it takes in the Stream of Consciousness of the Soul with a little experience will produce greatness.
- 5. If officers join an organization from arrogance they will fail and this will be seen in the corpses on the battlefield.
 - i. Being involved in the Interlocking System of Arrogance automatically cancels all potential for leadership and greatness.
 - ii. They may have the great experience but will fail completely since experience is no substitute for HONOR and INTEGRITY.

M. Principle:

- 1. The function of men in ranks in the military is NOT to think but to obey under combat pressures.
- 2. If the officers are lost then there is time for thinking and to switch to another scale of values.
 - i. You cannot take a small army and leave a reserve out of the campaign and march out with only 2 small corps.
- 3. Army functions take team work and someone must do the fighting and someone must do the thinking.
 - i. In the ranks of the military you are there to obey and do but when an officer you must think.
- 4. The principle of having a reserve force has been abandoned by the United States army because they are so outnumbered in europe and other places.
 - i. Today in 2013 they do not even have the means of logistical support structure for men in the field overseas and must rely on commercial air for support and supply.

- N. Reserve forces can be used also to exploit a breakthrough and does not just mean you are planning a retreat.
 - 1. They can be used to plug a gap and is also a security function of an army facing unknown situations.
 - 2. The brains of an army plans the battle then does nothing during the battle.
 - i. If something goes wrong then the commanders are consulted but he does not run around engaging in combat
 - ii. Brains of the army must be isolated in a safe area in order for thinking to be accomplished so that winning can occur.

XXX. Principles of Military Function and Spirituality:

- A. An army of stags led by a lion is more to be feared than an army of lions led by a stag.
 - 1. Sun Zu
 - i. Clever general avoids an army when its spirit is keen but attacks when it is sluggish and inclined to return.
 - ii. 5 dangerous faults which may effect a general
 - a. Recklessness which leads to destruction
 - b. Cowardice which leads to capture
 - c. A hasty temper which can be provoked by insults
 - d. Delicacy of honor which is shame
 - e. Over solicitude for his men which exposes him to worry and trouble.

iii. Principles:

- a. When the light chariots come out and form on the wings the enemy is preparing for battle.
- b. When some are seen advancing and some retreating it is a lure
- c. When soldiers are seen leaning on their spears they are weak from lack of food, attack.
- d. If those sent to draw water begin drinking themselves the army is suffering from thirst
- e. If the enemy sees an advantage to be gained and makes no effort to secure it the soldiers are exhausted.
- f. If birds gather on any spot it is unoccupied
- g. Clamor by night betokens nervousness
- h. If there are disturbances in the camp the general's authority is weak Attack.
- i. When an army feeds its horses with grain and kills its cattle for food and when the men don't hang their cooking pots over the campfires showing that they will not return to their tents they are determined to fight to the death.
- iv. 6 Calamities not arising from natural causes but from the generals fault:
 - a. Flight
 - i) If one force is 10x greater than another the smaller will flee
 - b. Insubordination
 - i) Soldiers too strong and officers too weak
 - c. Collapse
 - i) Officers too strong and soldiers too weak
 - d. Ruin
 - i) When the higher officers are angry and insubordinate and when on meeting the enemy give battle on their own account from a feeling of resentment before the commander and chief can decide if he is in position to fight
 - e. Disorganization
 - f. Rout

 i) General unable to estimate an enemies strength allows an inferior force against a larger one or hurls a weak detachment against a more powerful one without placing picked soldiers in the front rank.

XXXI. The civil or any war:

- A. He who selects the battlefield most often wins
 - 1. The army with the superior discipline most often prevails.
 - 2. In very rugged country with forest and mountains the army with the best discipline will prevail over the larger force as the large force may lose communication and will not be able to maneuver.
 - i. In this type of fighting the individual quality of the troop is what counts in the battle.
 - 3. See Napoleon at Austerlitz
 - i. Select your own battlefield and meet people in business on your terms not theirs.
 - 4. The army with strong discipline has enforced humility and humility wins every time whether enforced or genuine

B. Principle of Objective:

- 1. First neutralization or destruction of the enemy force
- 2. The mission must be compatible with the objective of destroying the army and restoration of order and law and its Laws of Divine Establishment and client nation functions.
- 3. Offensive action is the only Modus Operandi by which that objective can be accomplished.
- 4. Offensive brings victory while defense can only avoid defeat.
- 5. Offensive not only defeats and destroys an enemy force but at the same time increases the efficiency of the establishment forces.
- 6. Three benefits to taking offensive:
 - i. Raises morale
 - ii. Gives freedom of action
 - iii. Provides concentration of effort.
 - iv. True in business, marketing, and the Spiritual Life
 - v. Learning Bible Doctrine raises the believers morale, gives greater options for decisions in life in freedom of action and concentrates your effort giving greater capacities for life, love and happiness.
- 7. Defensive should be used to assist Offensive action elsewhere, gain time, use good terrain or compensate for weakness
 - i. It is better to hit while the enemy is in column preparing to move to line formations
 - ii. Holding actions should lure the enemy into a situation for single or double envelopment
- 8. Offensive should be used when and where there is any reasonable chance of success.
 - i. Combat power must be concentrated at the point of maximum effectiveness
 - ii. Economy of force is the means by which combat force can be deployed.
 - iii. Combat elements must be maneuvered to contact the enemy at the point of his advantage and secure decisive results
 - iv. Use of security must be effective to screen movements from the enemy.
 - v. Thus a larger force may be defeated by a much smaller one.
- 9. Mountainous terrain gives advantage to those who inhabit it first forcing advancement only alone specific areas of movement into the mountains.
- C. The implications of this type of battle:
 - 1. When there is no self nor group discipline the result is that a lot of people die.
 - 2. There must be self discipline for any capacity for life, love and happiness in life and it has to be self imposed.

- 3. These things cannot be experience without self imposed discipline.
- D. Victory is impossible without good tactical disposition, excellent plan, proper use of personnel and proper use of terrain.
- E. Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls Human History and the hard corps revolutionaries are the ones who WILL die.
 - 1. No good ever comes from rejecting Laws of Divine Establishment government and participating in conspiracy against it.
 - 2. Freedom can only exist under the authority of establishment government whatever the category of government.
 - 3. Retreat in panic spreads panic and many people will die when they collectively cannot think under pressure.
 - 4. In panic people do not properly negotiate rugged terrain and often do not avoid dangerous wildlife.
 - 5. Many people die because of emotional arrogance and inability to think.
- F. Victory in battle does not resolve problems but the function of government after battlefield victory which determines the true results of battlefield success.
