

Psalm 115

v1: Not to us, O LORD, not to us, but to your name give glory, because of your steadfast love and your faithfulness and doctrine!

v2: Why should the gentiles the Jebusites say, "Where now is their God?"

v3: But our God is in the heavens; he does whatever he pleases, Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ controls history.

v4: Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.

v5: They have mouths, but cannot speak; eyes, but cannot see.

v6: They have ears, but cannot hear; noses, but cannot smell.

v7: They have hands, but they cannot feel; feet, but they cannot walk; and those cannot make a sound in their throat.

v8: Those who make them will become like them; so are all who trust in them.

v9: Oh Israel, Trust in the Lord, He is your help and your shield.

v10: Oh House of Aaron, put your trust in the Lord, he is your help and your shield.

v11: You who respect by fear, the Lord, trust in the Lord, he is your help and your shield.

v12: The LORD has been mindful of us; he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron;

v13: he will bless those who fear the LORD, both small and great.

v14: May the LORD give you increase, you and your children!

v15: May you be blessed by the LORD, who made heaven and earth!

v16: The heavens are the LORD's heavens, but the earth he has given to the sons of men.

v17: The dead do not praise the LORD, nor do any that go down into silence.

v18: But we will Praise the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. Praise the LORD!
