- v0: A Psalm of David.
- v1: I will be caused to praise you, Oh Jehovah, with the whole of the Right Lobe of the Stream of Consciousness of my Soul; In the presence of the Elohim, God the Father, God the Holy Spirit, and God the Son; I will compose a song to him;
- v2: I will personally in an uncoerced fashion continually learn Bible Doctrine and bow down toward the palace of your provision, and I will be caused to praise your essence or character because of your steadfast love or Grace and your doctrine; for You have exalted or magnified the categorical principles of doctrine found in scripture even above your person or reputation.
- v3: In the day when I cried you answered me, my strength of soul you did increase.
- v4: All the kings of the earth shall praise you, O LORD, for they have heard the words of your mouth;
- v5: and they shall sing of the ways and glory of the LORD, for great is the glory of the LORD.
- v6: For though the LORD is infinitely superior to man, he looks down on the super-grace believer who have Positive Volition to Bible Doctrine in time of disaster and still delivers him; but the arrogant reversionist he loves from a great distance.
- v7: Though I have a way of life still in the middle of pressure, you will refresh my life; you have stretched forth your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and your right hand shall deliver me in the future.
- v8: The LORD will complete the plan that concerns me; your steadfast love and grace, O LORD, endures for ever. You will NOT forsake the work of your hands.
