- v0: A Psalm of David, when he was in the desert of Judah.
- v1: Oh God, you are my God, early do I seek you, my soul is thirsty for you; my body longs for you, in a dry and weary land where there is no water.
- v2: I have seen you in the tabernacle I went to see your power and glory.
- v3: Because your steadfast love or Grace is better than life, therefore my lips will praise you.
- v4: I will praise you as long as I live; and in your name I will lift up my hands in prayer.
- v5: My soul will be satisfied with your marrow and fatness or rich food in a banquet or the Metabolized Bible Doctrine in my Stream of Consciousness of the Soul, and my lips will praise you,
- v6: On my bed I remember you in doctrinal application, I think of you during night watches;
- v7: because you are my help, I sing in the shadow of your wings.
- v8: My soul clings to you in doctrinal rationales of reverse concentration; your right hand sustains and protects me.
- v9: The revolutionists who seek my life will be destroyed they will go down into the depths of the earth in their graves;
- v10: They will be delivered to the sword, they will become food for the jackals.
- v11: But the king will rejoice in God; everyone who swears by him the establishment force will praise God for deliverance but the mouths of those who speak lies the revolutionists will be stopped.
