- v1: LORD, thou wast favorable to thy land; thou didst restore the fortunes of Jacob.
- v2: Thou didst forgive the iniquity of thy people; thou didst pardon all their sin. [Selah]
- v3: Thou didst withdraw all thy wrath; thou didst turn from thy hot anger.
- v4: Restore us again, O God of our salvation, and put away thy indignation toward us!
- v5: Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? Wilt thou prolong thy anger to all generations?
- v6: Wilt thou not revive us again, that thy people may rejoice in thee?
- v7: Show us thy steadfast love, O LORD, and grant us thy salvation.
- v8: With Positive Volition I will concentrate on what the God Jehovah will communicate, for He will communicate prosperity to his people, Israel the client nation, to his, Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ's, Mature Gracious believers in the Pivot, but let them not return to a status of foolish weakness of mind or reversionism. v9: Emphatically, nothing but His, Jesus of Nazareth, The Christ's, deliverance is near for those who are
- occupied with him, that glory may dwell permanently as an advantage in our client nation.

v10: Steadfast love, GRACE or Mercy and Doctrine have met one another together; Righteousness of God imputed at Salvation Adjustment to the Justice of God and Prosperity have joined or fused mouth to mouth or kissed each other and belong together.

v11: Absolute truth of Doctrine will sprout or shine forth from the land as missionaries, and the Absolute Righteousness of God will look down from or be offered from heaven.

v12: The LORD also himself will give the good as the Plan of God and blessing for the nation, and our land shall give her increase, wealth in terms of agricultural economy.

v13: Righteousness shall go before his, God's, face as motivation, that he, believers with Positive Volition, may put or place his steps as persistent and consistent concentration in learning Bible Doctrine, toward the way to Spiritual Maturity.
