Prayer for Compassion

Joel 2:17+

- v17: "Let the priests, the ministers of Jehovah or God, weep or offer a prayer or lamentation in time of calamity between the porch and the altar of Solomon's Temple, and let them say, "Have compassion on or exercise grace on Your people, O Jehovah or God and give not Your heritage to reproach with the result that the nations or gentiles should rule over them [Jews]. Therefore, should they say among the people, "Where is their 'Elohim or Godhead?"
- v18: "Then will Jehovah or God be zealous for His land, and have compassion {His love expressed in terms of protection} for His people."
- v19: "Yes, Jehovah or God will answer and say unto His people, "Behold, I will send you corn, and wine, and oil or economic prosperity and you will be satisfied therewith or happy with it, And I will no more make you a reproach among the gentiles or nations
