Workshop — Tatted Snowflake

Design and Execution by Cristel Wutzmer, Kranichfeld, Germany. Adapted from Tina Frauberger.

Materials: 2 shuttles, Hakelgarn size 30

This snowflake is made of a center motif and 6 motif points, each of the motif points are attached while working the completed pattern to each other and the central motif at the same time.

Center Motif:

R. 5-8-5.

Repeat five times so that there are six rings all together. Cut and Tie.

Motif Points (begin at letter A):

Ring 1: 4-4-4-, Cl R, RW.

Chain 2: 5-5-5, RW

Ring 2: 4 + (to second picot on R1) 6-6, Cl R, RW.

Chain 2: 5-5, RW.

Ring 3: 6 + (to R2) 3-6-3-3, Cl R, RW.

Chain 3 5-5, R on Ch (5-5), 5-5 + (to third picot on R3) 5-5, RW.

Ring 4: 6 + (to second picot on R3) 6-4, Cl R, RW.

Chain 4: 5-5-5, RW.

Ring 5: 4-4 + (to picot on R4) 4-4, CL R, RW.

Chain 5: 5-5, R on Ch (5 + (to picot on Center Motif) 5), 5-5.

Cut and tie to base of R1.

Repeat 5 times.

Join the second point motif to the next (going counterclockwise) at the first picot of chain 1 to the last picot of chain 4.

Join the last motif point to the first.
