

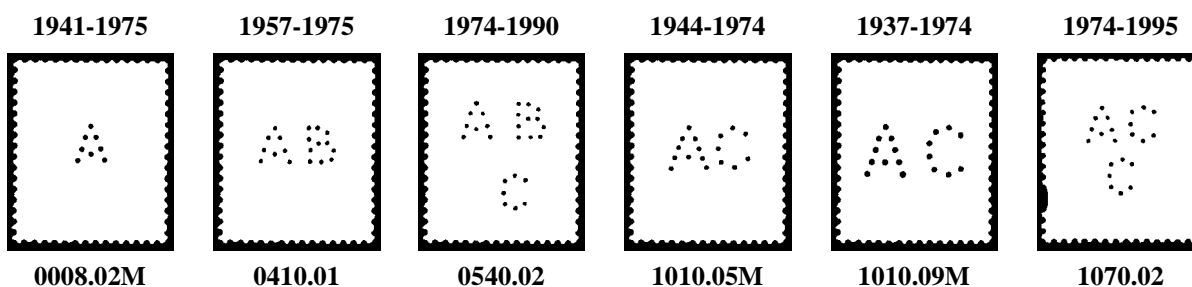
Machin Decimal Issues.

The following list of **27 dies** and **297 stamps** shows the Machin issues 'W', 'W(ell)' and decimal 'Regionals' listed in the main body of the **Gault Catalogue of G.B. Perfins**. This list automatically includes details from **Barrie Williamson's Machin Study** for these issues. The 'codes' used (i.e. 4b, 10a, 13½ etc) are those used by Barrie Williamson in his list.

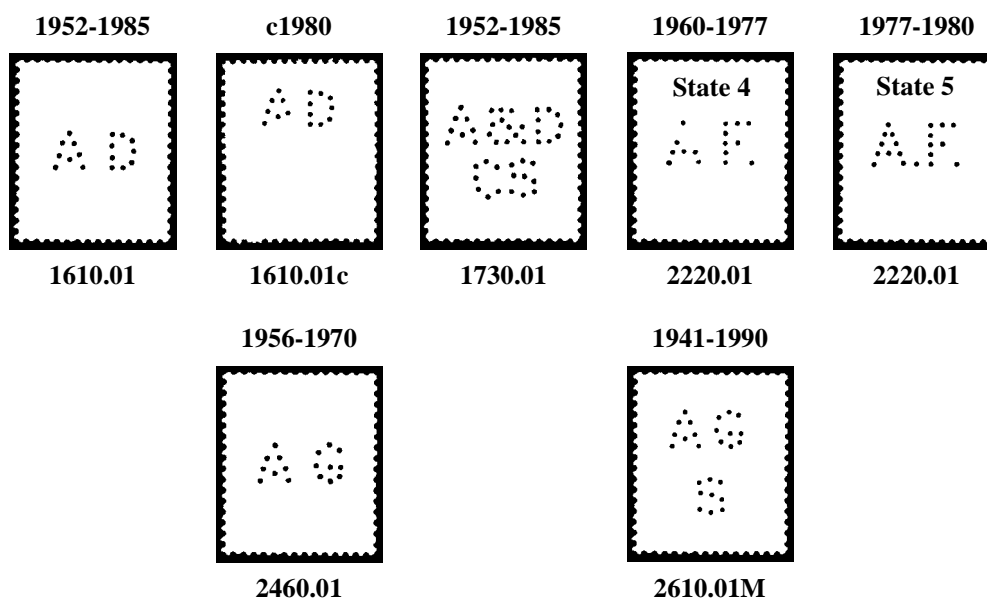

Note: Unusually for a Sloper product, strikes from c1958 are **reversed!**

A **single headed** die known used by:

- Associated Newspapers Ltd, 'Daily Mail', Carmelite House, Carmelite Court, London EC. Note: As with A4230.01M above, strikes **may** also be found **reversed!**

A4720.03 A.R. W 3, 16½ **Total 2**

A **single headed** die fitted to a perforating press once in the possession of Michael Rucklidge.

Believed to have been used by:

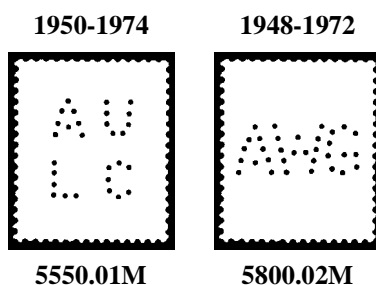
- Andrew Riddell, Edinburgh. {See PS Bulletin 200, page 2}. These are **sample strikes** taken **after** the perforating machine had ceased being used in business - not known on any other postage stamps.

A multiheaded die, probably **6x1**, known used by:

- A W Gamage Ltd, Military, Athletic & General Outfitters, Holborn, London EC1.
Latest known date used 11th March 1971.

Please note:

- ‘ss’ against any denomination refers to ‘Security Slits’.
- ‘SA’ refers to Self Adhesive stamps.
- ‘S’ and ‘L’ are Small and Large ‘Price in Proportion’ (PiP) stamps.
- ‘SD’ Source and Date codes ‘hidden’ in ‘iridescent’ overprint on Self Adhesive stamps.
