TECHNICAL DATA SHEET

DESCRIPTION:

Lanco Mixture 200 Clear Finishing Stain

USES:

Formulated for use as a finish over exterior Mixture 200 systems, unpainted concrete patios, decks, sidewalks, and driveways, concrete tennis courts and masonry walls. May be used on similar interior surfaces but only in well-ventilated areas. Do not use near open flame, pilot lights, and sparks

Arcs. Etc. Mixture 200 is formulated to resist peeling, cracking, chipping and mildew. It's semi-gloss hard finish resists chemicals, acids, salts, detergents, chlorine, and mildew.

PACKAGING:

Mixture 200 is available in 5-gallon pails.

COVERAGE:

Coverage depends upon the porosity of the surface to be coated. Theoretical coverage of 150 square feet per gallon at 1 mil DFT on a smooth surface is obtainable. The recommended coverage is 100 to 150 square feet per gallon per coat, 2 coats recommended.

SURFACE PREPARATION:

Surface must be dry and clean of dust, dirt, oils, and other contaminants.

MIXING:

Thoroughly stir contents prior to application.

APPLICATION:

May be applied by brush, roller or spray. Apply only when surface temperatures are 50°F or higher. Do not apply to excessively hot surfaces because rapid drying may cause trapped vapors to bubble. Drying too rapidly may also prevent proper penetration into the substrate. Apply evenly with brush, roller or spray equipment. A 1/8" polyester nap roller is recommended. For spray applications, use a tip designed for application of gloss enamel coatings.

CLEAN-UP:

Roller covers should be discarded after use. Application equipment can be cleaned with Xylene or Toluol.

PRECAUTIONS:

<u>DANGER:</u> Causes eye burns. Vapor is harmful. May cause allergic skin reactions.
