## Schedule: The info below describes the Day Pass Schedule: (Updated April 2012)

8:45 to 9:00am Arrival: Enter the Camp at the **DAY PASS entrance** and park at the **Day Pass** 

**Parking Lot – P8.** Parking attendants will provide direction. After parking, walk to Pedersen Lodge to register your unit. Send 1 person per Unit to register your unit. At that time you will receive <u>Patches</u> & <u>Event Cards</u>. Then you may walk to the Event Areas with your unit. (Refer to the CTC Map in the Leader's Package).

Logistics: Patches: Day pass get the <u>large CTC patch and a button loop patch</u> at the Registration Desk. Day

Pass people can earn the Program patches by doing the Events as listed on the Event Card.

CTC Trading Post / Camporee Store: In Eagle Lodge

**<u>Babcock Hovey "Trading Post"</u>**: Building near the north end of the walking bridge.

## **Bathroom Facilities?**

-Flush Toilets: Are located in the shower House.

**-Port a Potties:** Are located in the middle of the Subcamp / Field

-<u>Latrines / Outhouses</u>: Are located in several areas. Look for the small dark Brown wooden Outhouse / Buildings with Hand Washing Sinks outside. Port a Johns will also be on site.

9:00 to 12 noon **Events:** Participate in the ~ 530 Events offered to the Scouting Youth.

**NOTE**: Youth can earn up to <u>7 Program Patches</u> by doing Events as per the Event Card. Program Patches are included in the Registration fees..... Pick them up at <u>1<sup>st</sup> Aid</u>

12 Noon to 1:15pm **Lunch:** Pizza Lunch in the Dining Hall (included in registration fee)

If we have over 300 people, please allow others to sit after you are done eating.

Finished Lunch early? Go visit Troops to see how they organize meals and

their Campsites. This event is on your event card.

No hurry! Event Areas do not open until 1:15pm.
