ORDER

Fifth pay commission had recommended that for a post having qualifications of B.Sc/ Diploma in Engineering as essential eligibility condition at the entry level and in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1400-2300, a higher replacement pay scale of Rs. 5000-8000 may be allowed. Similarly for a post having prescribed qualification of an Engineering Degree/M.Sc. and in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 1640-2900 the higher replacement pay scale of Rs. 6500-10500 may be made admissible. In respect of posts in the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 2000-3500 and for which the prescribed minimum educational qualification is an Engineering Degree/M.Sc. at the entry level may be given higher replacement pay of Rs. 7500-12000.

2. It has been decided with the approval of Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure (Pay implementation Cell) that in accordance with the above recommendations of the 5th Central Pay Commission, the following replacement pay scales will be admissible to the Group 'B' and 'C' Scientific posts (Junior Analysts, Technical Assistants and Junior Technical Assistants) in the Department of Science & Technology w.e.f. 1.1.96:-
