# Printing Calendars

---

- Print the calendars on 8 ½ X 11” paper.
- Use a paper cutter to cut the pages in half.
- Use a hole punch to make the holes at the top. An old calendar page will make a good pattern for hole placement.

For best results, may I suggest using:

- A color laser printer or laser jet
- Card Stock paper (110 weight) in cream, ivory or white

If you do not have access to a color printer you can use the calendar that has black ink to print. If you do not want to print the calendar yourself, you can take the website address to a copy shop or office supply store that does printing and have it printed there.

For a different look try printing several calendars, each in a different color ink. Then arrange the pages so the months alternate from red ink to blue, then green, then brown, etc. You will have extra calendars and you can tie a ribbon through the holes and place one on a desk and another on the refrigerator...anywhere an extra calendar would be handy.
