This year we have selected 11 students from all three CCISD high schools to participate in the FFA partnership/show program. This seems to be the best "group" of students that I have had the opportunity to put together as a team. They are a cross-section of academic, socio-economic and agricultural backgrounds. They have already demonstrated a very high level of commitment and dedication to caring for and exhibiting your cattle at the selected shows across the state.

Your cattle have changed tremendously since arrival to our program. They have grown at an amazing rate and are healthy, happy, spoiled heifers and bulls. We often refer to our center as the "Day Spa for Cattle." I had to politely interrupt a parent and his child this past weekend and tell them that if they brushed and shined that heifer any more, I think her hair will fall out! They are all halter broke and behaving very nicely in the show ring. We are working hard on our showmanship techniques and longhorn facts so

that we are represented our very best in the show ring. We are feeding a medicated show heifer grower and a medicated show bull ration along with our extra vitamins and hay. Their diets will change throughout the year according to their progress. We want them in condition; however, we certainly do not want them fat. We keep them on a routine health maintenance program with vitamin B12 and monthly wormings.

We attended the ITLA Texas Rice Festival to give the team of students the opportunity to go through a "real" show experience. The students did a super job working together and handling the cattle. You would have been very pleased with all of them. Included is a summary of our show results. Not all of the cattle were exhibited. If they were not 1809 days old or we felt like they were not ready, we did not make them travel. The show results are as follows:


