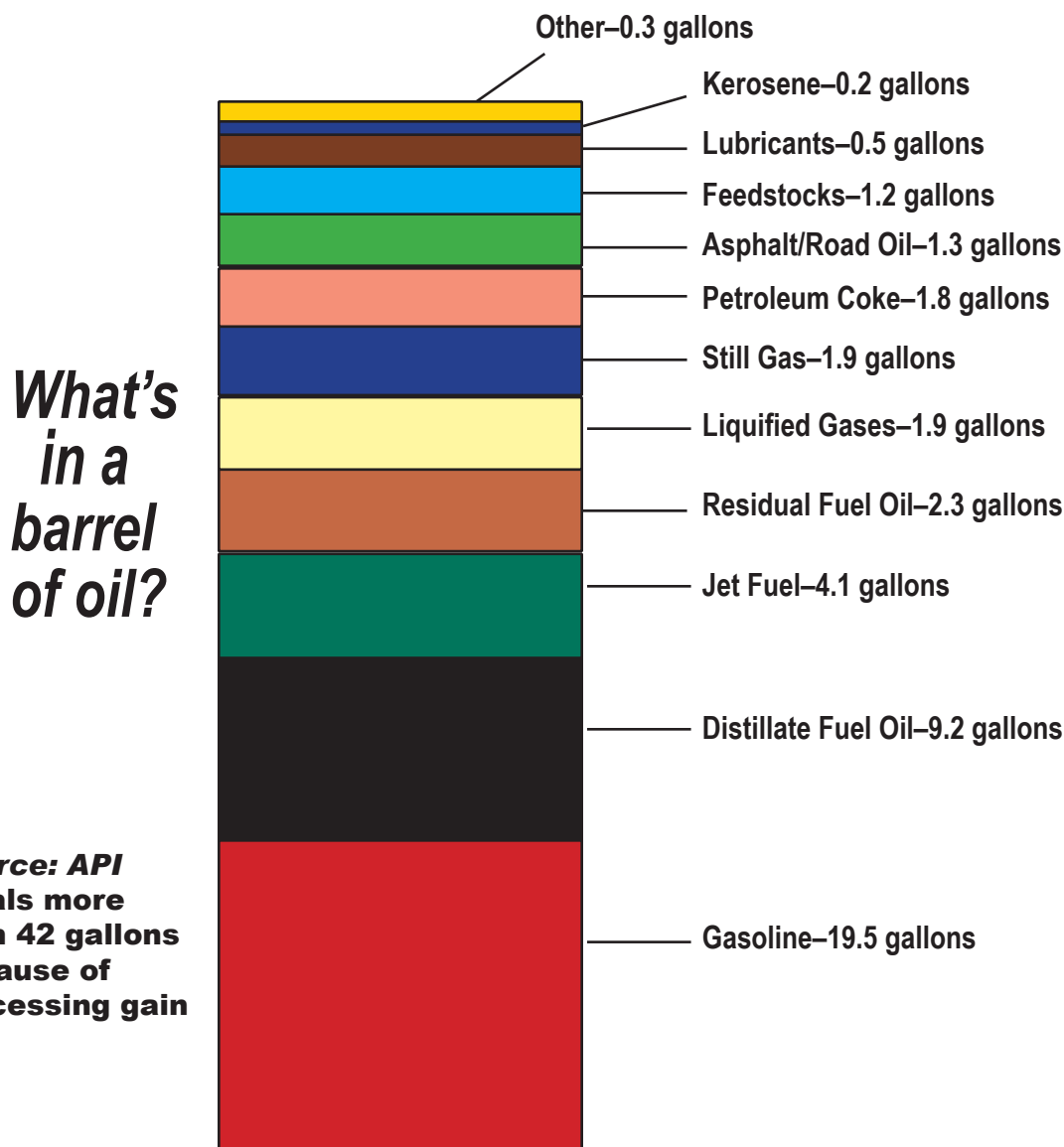


How many gallons of gasoline from one barrel of crude?



One barrel contains 42 gallons of crude oil. The total volume of products made is 44.2 gallons—2.2 gallons greater than the original 42 gallons of crude oil. “Processing gain” occurs when other chemicals are added to the refining process to create the products.
